On June 13, 2024, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) received ~~Aim Energy Group, Inc.'s~~ Application for a Natural Gas Supplier (NGS) license.

The applicant stated throughout its NGS Application Package that the name of the applicant is "Aim Energy Group Inc.". According to the applicant's PA Department of State registered name, the name must be written as "Aim Energy Group, Inc." (notice the punctuation difference). All instances of this error must be corrected throughout the NGS Application Package.

~~Sections 7.a, 7.b, and 7.e~~ of the Application were incomplete or not properly completed. In order for the Commission to accept the Application for review, these deficiencies must be corrected. Failure to respond timely will result in the Application being deemed rejected¹ and the docket will be closed.

Please use the Commission's e filing system or an overnight delivery service to submit the requested information to the Secretary of the Commission **within 20 days** from the date of this letter. Please submit revised Application pages for each section. Notice of filing of this Application must be published in newspapers of general circulation covering each county in which the applicant intends to provide service. The newspapers in which proof of publication are required is dependent on the service territories the applicant is proposing to serve.

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
