4. Cancellation Provisions:

Non-Payment – If your natural gas service is terminated by your NGDC, then this agreement is cancelled on the date that your natural gas service is terminated. You will owe us for amounts unpaid for our charges for natural gas supply service up to the date of termination by your NGDC.

Company-Initiated Cancellation – If we cancel this agreement for any reason other than for customer non-payment, we will follow applicable rules in providing notice to you.

Customer-Initiated Cancellation – If you cancel this agreement before the end of the initial term, you will owe us for amounts unpaid up to the date of cancellation.

Rights of Rescission: You may cancel this agreement at any time before midnight of the third business day after receiving this disclosure. You can contact us by phone, in writing or electronically (if available) to cancel this agreement. See Section (X) for how to contact us.

Cancellation or Transferring Service because of Relocating:

Customer moves outside NGDC's territory: If the customer moves from the address listed above outside of the NGDC's territory or outside Mercury Energy Marketing's service territory, this agreement is cancelled, and you will be served under your NGDC's regulated service commodity rate unless you select another natural gas supplier.

Customer moves within NGDC's territory: If you relocate within your NGDC's service territory, you must (a) call your NGDC at the telephone number located under the contact information in Section 20 to inform the NGDC of your request to transfer your NGDC service to your new location; (b) obtain your new account information from the NGDC; and (c) contact Mercury Energy Marketing at the telephone number in Section 20 to provide your new account information and location to complete the transfer of service.

5. Fees, Penalties, and Exceptions: You will not be assessed an early termination fee if you cancel or terminate this Agreement prior to the end of the Term.

6. These authorizations shall remain in effect as long as this Agreement (including renewal) is in effect. 10. Warranty: MERCURY ENERGY MARKETING MAKES NO REPRESENTATIONS OF WARRANTIES OTHER THAN THOSE EXPRESSLY SET FORTH IN THIS AGREEMENT. MERCURY ENERGY MARKETING EXPRESSLY DISCLAIMS ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING THE WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE

11. Force Majeure (Uncontrollable Forces): Mercury Energy Marketing will make commercially reasonable efforts to provide natural gas service but does not guarantee continuous supply of natural gas. Certain causes and events out of the control of Mercury Energy Marketing ("Force Majeure Event(s)") may result in interruptions of service. Mercury Energy Marketing will not be liable for any such interruptions caused by a Force Majeure Event. Mercury Energy Marketing does not transmit or distribute natural gas. 


