**ORDER
GRANTING COMPLAINANT’S MOTION FOR
CONTINUANCE AND DIRECTING A CASE STATUS CONFERENCE**

By Scheduling Order dated March 5, 2024, evidentiary hearings were scheduled in this matter for June 13, 2024 and June 18, 2024.¹ On May 31, 2024, the Complainant, Ms. Ann Marie Luyando, filed a Motion for Continuance, requesting a continuance of these hearing dates for medical reasons.² Ms. Luyando requested a continuance for “no less than 180 days.” The Respondent, Newtown Artesian Water Company, filed an Answer to this Motion. In its Answer, the Company did not object to a 90-day continuance with a status conference to be scheduled for some time in September 2024.

By email dated June 4, 2020, I informed the parties that in light of the reasons for the Complainant’s Motion and the Company’s response, the June 2024 hearings dates would be continued. Accordingly, by notices issued this same day, the June 13 and 18, 2024 hearings were cancelled.

The purpose of this Order is to formally grant the Complainant’s Motion and to schedule a case status conference. I deem that a status conference would be helpful to move this
