Application of the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for approval to alter the public above grade crossing by the replacement of the existing bridge carrying State Route 0011 (West King Street) over track of Norfolk Southern Railway Company (DOT 592 122 M) in Shippensburg Borough and Southampton Township, Franklin County, and the allocation of costs incident thereto.

To Whom It May Concern:

By Secretarial Letter dated May 28, 2024, we directed the alteration of the crossing where State Route 0011 (King Street) crosses track of Norfolk Southern Railway Company, above grade, in Shippensburg Borough and Southampton Township, Franklin County. All work at the subject crossing is to be completed on or before December 31, 2026.

In accordance with numbered Paragraphs 3 and 4 of the Commission's Secretarial Letter May 28, 2024, in the above-captioned proceeding, the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has submitted final construction and structural plans for the proposed project for review by all parties and this Commission's approval.

The plan set, which includes: the Traffic Control Plan, Signing and Pavement Marking Plan, Water Line Relocation Plan, Erosion and Sedimentation Control Plan, Traffic Signal Control Plan, Structure Plan, Cross Section Plan, Post Construction Storm Water Management Plan, and the Existing Structure Plan, were received on July 23, 2024. A revised copy the Erosion and Sedimentation Control plan and the Post Construction Storm Water Management Plan was received on July 30, 2024. The complete plan set, including the revised plans received July 30, 2024, are entitled "COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION DRAWINGS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF STATE ROUTE 0011 IN FRANKLIN COUNTY" and consist of one hundred fifty-nine (159) sheets.

All parties in interest were provided a copy of the plans and none of the parties have responded with any objections.

Please be advised that the above plans have been certified as the correct plans and are hereby approved. The Commission issues this Secretarial Letter in accordance with Section 2702 of the Public Utility Code.

The Parties are reminded that failure to comply with this or any Order or Secretarial Letter in this proceeding may result in an enforcement action seeking civil penalties and/or other sanctions pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 3301.



Parties are encouraged to file formal documents by eFiling with the Secretary of the Commission by opening an Efiling account through the Commission's website (the account is free of charge) and accepting eservice at <https://www.puc.pa.gov/filing-resources/efiling/>.

If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to file by overnight delivery to ensure the timely filing of your submission. There are certain filings that cannot be eFiled, such as filings containing confidential or proprietary material. These must be submitted to the Secretary by overnight delivery, priority, or certified mail to allow tracking of your filing.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.31 and 5.44, file a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The Petition shall be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission or sent to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, and must be filed within twenty (20) days, or if no timely request is made, the action will be deemed to be a final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request; (2) the case docket number (it is provided for you at the top right hand corner of this letter); (3) the party on whose behalf the petition is made; (4) a Certificate of Service on the other parties of record; and (5) a Verification with original signature in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36.
