**Re: Petition of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation for Approval of Major  
Modifications to its Existing Long-Term Infrastructure Improvement Plan**

Dear Devin Ryan:

On July 11, 2024, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) entered an Opinion and Order at Docket No. P-2022-3034972 (July Opinion and Order) that approved the Petition of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (PPL) for approval of a major modification of PPL's existing Long-Term Infrastructure Improvement Plan (LTIIP). The July Opinion and Order further directed PPL to file a clean version of its modified LTIIP within 30 days of the entry of the July Opinion and Order. The clean version of PPL's modified LTIIP was to include the removal of the information related to the Predictive Failure Technology (PFT) and incorporate any updated tables and clarifying information provided by PPL in its responses to the Data Requests of the Commission.

On August 12, 2024, PPL filed clean and redline versions of its modified LTIIP at the above referenced docket number. PPL's redline version showed, in redline, the changes made to the modified LTIIP that was submitted with its Petition. However, the clean version did not properly incorporate those redline changes. On August 27, 2024, PPL filed a corrected clean version of its modified LTIIP, which removed the information related to the PFT and incorporated the necessary updated information. Accordingly, PPL appears to have substantially complied with the directives of the July Opinion and Order and this proceeding shall be marked closed.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition with the Commission within twenty (20) days after the date of this
