Response: The ultimate parent of PEG Bandwidth PA, LLC and Southern Light, LLC is Uniti Group Inc. (collectively, "Uniti"). Uniti Group Inc. is a publicly traded company (NASDAQ: UNIT). The valuation of Uniti Group Inc. is represented by its market capitalization, which is approximately \$1.02 billion.

Windstream Holdings II, LLC is privately held and, therefore, does not have a valuation based upon a publicly traded stock price. However, in this Transaction between Windstream and Uniti Group Inc., Windstream's pre-closing equity holders will be receiving consideration for their equity in Windstream consisting of (1) \$425 million of cash; (2) preferred equity in the combined company that will result from the Transaction with an initial liquidation preference of \$575 million; (3) approximately 35.42% of the common equity in the combined company; and (4) warrants to acquire up to 6.9% of the common shares in the combined company.

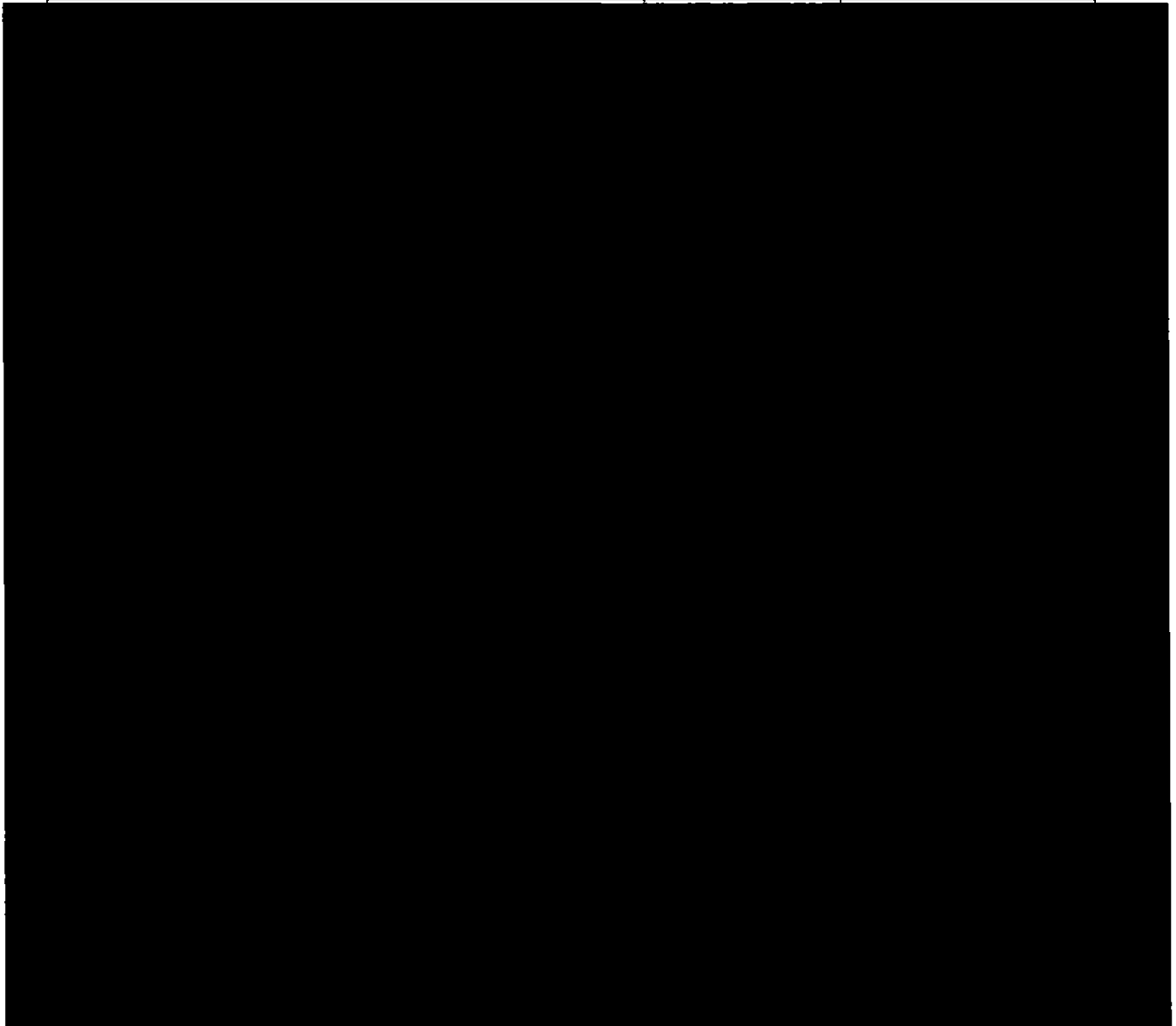

The Transaction will enhance Windstream Parent, Inc.'s ability to effectively leverage Uniti and Windstream's respective assets, expertise, and competencies than either company could do alone. 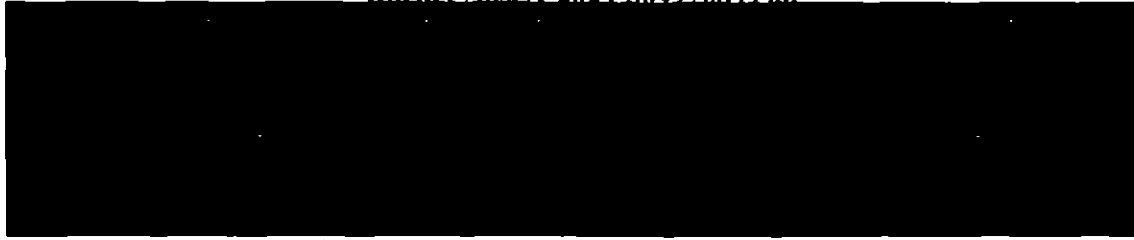

Response: By the terms of the Agreement executed by the parties, the Transaction is subject to various conditions precedent including the receipts of consents, approvals, and clearances by the FCC (including review by the Committee for the Assessment of Foreign Participation in the United States Telecommunications Services Sector (the "Committee") f/k/a "Team Telecom"), and state regulatory agencies with jurisdiction. Action by this Commission will not prejudice, hasten, or otherwise affect the national security review of the Committee, which is wholly independent of state regulatory approvals. As demonstrated by multiple other regulated transactions, the Committee and the FCC will continue their reviews regardless of whether state regulatory agencies have completed their separate reviews. Any national security concerns will be addressed during the confidential review process of the Committee, which is the expert agency for national security issues. Historically, the FCC will not act on the pending applications until the Committee clears the transaction, either by withdrawing its deferral request notifying the FCC that its concerns have been satisfied during the course of its review or by petitioning the FCC to impose conditions on any consent given to address the Committee's national security concerns. Consequently, action by this Commission prior to any FCC approval, or Committee clearance would not prejudice those reviews or in any way harm national security.

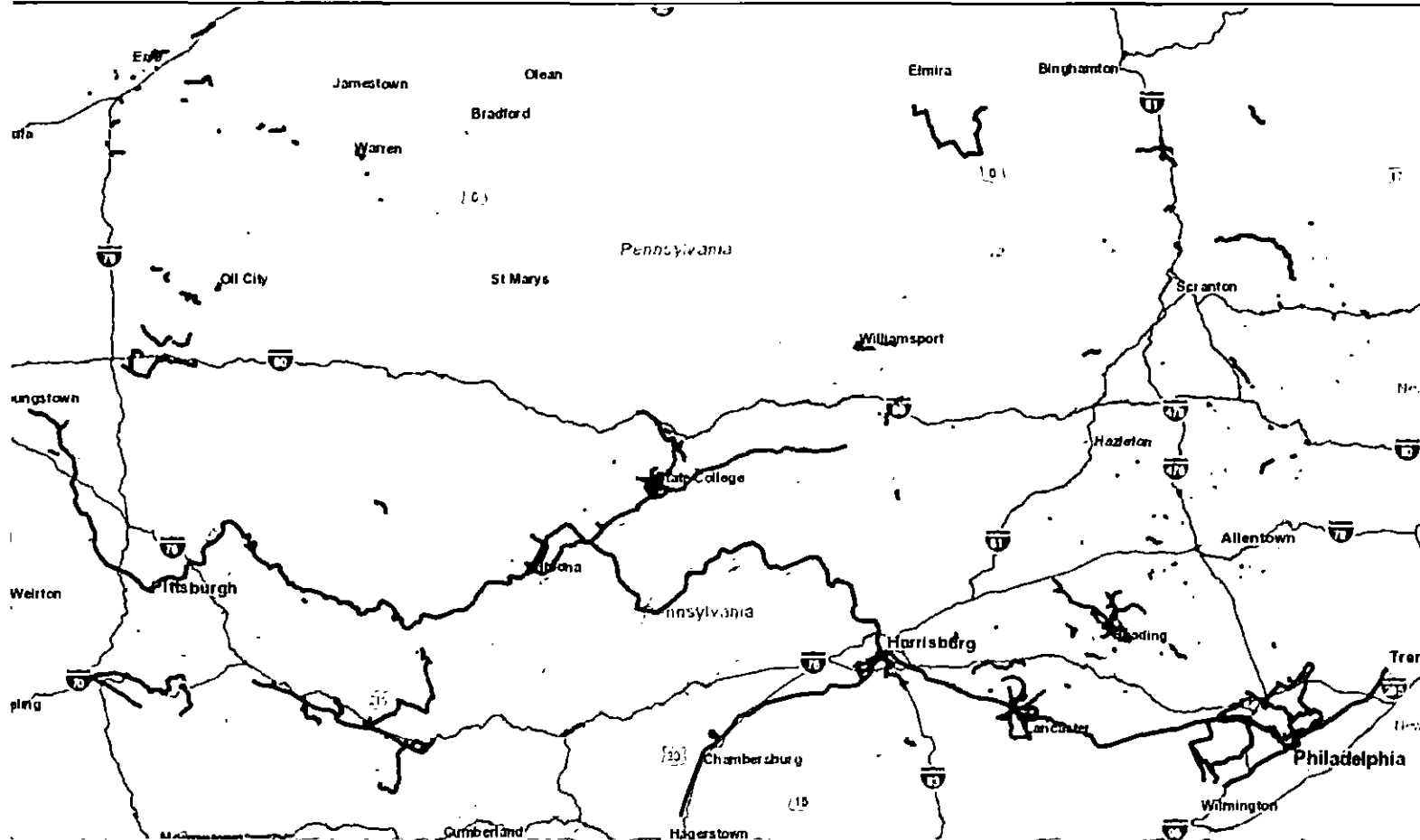



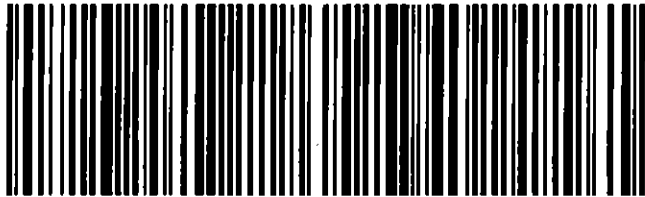
