**INTERIM ORDER CANCELLING PREHEARING CONFERENCE  
AND DIRECTING PARTIES TO PROVIDE STATUS UPDATES**

By Initial Call-In Telephonic Hearing Notice dated August 1, 2024, a Call-In Telephonic Prehearing Conference was scheduled for September 26, 2024 at 10:00 a.m.

By Prehearing Conference Order dated August 8, 2024, I directed the parties to comply with various procedural requirements and also directed the parties to file and serve prehearing conference memoranda on or before September 19, 2024.

By email received on September 16, 2024, Colby B. Widdowson, Esq., Counsel for the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) indicated: that the parties have engaged in preliminary settlement discussions; that both parties believe settlement is the most likely outcome for this matter; that the parties were requesting that the filing of prehearing conference memoranda and the telephonic Prehearing Conference be continued; and that the parties would provide monthly status reports. Christopher A. Lewis, Esq., Counsel for PECO Energy Company, subsequently informed me that PECO concurs with I&E's request.

As the parties' request is reasonable, it will be granted.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the parties do not need to file prehearing conference memoranda on or before September 19, 2024;
2. That the Prehearing Conference scheduled for September 26, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. is cancelled;
3. That the parties are directed to provide the Presiding Officer with a status report on their ongoing settlement discussions within thirty (30) days of the date of this Interim Order, and every thirty (30) days thereafter until they either file a joint petition for approval of settlement or determine that settlement discussions have stalled; and
4. That if the Parties do not file the status report as directed in Ordering Paragraph #3, this matter be rescheduled for a prehearing conference.
