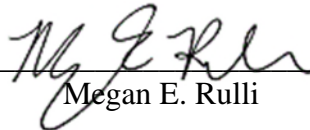

**REPLY OF DUQUESNE LIGHT COMPANY TO THE
EXCEPTION OF TODD ELLIOT KOGER**

I. INTRODUCTION

Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light” or the “Company”), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.535, hereby respectfully submits this Reply to the Exception of Todd Elliot Koger (“Complainant”). In the Initial Decision (“ID”), Administrative Law Judge Conrad A. Johnson (the “ALJ”) dismissed the Complainant’s Formal Complaint alleging that the Company wrongfully terminated service, violated prior settlements, violated federal statutes, and conspired with municipal employees to withhold service termination notices resulting in the denial of grant applications. The ALJ correctly held that the Complainant failed to prove by a preponderance of evidence that the Company violated a Commission statute, regulation, or order.

On August 15, 2024, the Complainant filed his Exception to the ID.

As explained herein, the Complainant’s Exception is without merit and should be denied. Accordingly, the Company respectfully requests that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) deny the Complainant’s Exception and adopt the ID without modification.

II. REPLY TO EXCEPTION NO. 1 – THE COMPLAINANT WAS AFFORDED DUE PROCESS, AND HIS ALLEGATIONS OF UNETHICAL CONDUCT AND BIAS ARE COMPLETELY WITHOUT MERIT

The Complainant argues in his Exception that he was not afforded a fair hearing because the ALJ “was obligated to recuse himself” under Rule 2.11 of the Pennsylvania Code of Judicial Conduct, due to unfounded allegations of a conflict that made it “feasible that concerns about impartiality were a play in the case C--2023-3038703 [sic].” (Exception, pp. 2, 4.) As alleged support, the Complainant contends that the ALJ “previously served as legal counsel for Todd Elliot Koger, Sr. in a matter concerning Defendants accused of participating in an ongoing RICO conspiracy (identified as case number 24-02040-GLT) in the Bankruptcy Court of Western District

of Pennsylvania,”¹ and that the ALJ was “involve[d] in confidential matters during the C--2023-3038703 proceedings.” (Exception, pp. 2, 4.) The Complainant also contends that he raised this objection and requested for the ALJ to recuse himself “timely” and “repeatedly.” (Exception, pp. 2, 3.)

Rule 2.11 of the Pennsylvania Code of Judicial Conduct require judges to disqualify themselves “in any proceeding in which the judge’s impartiality might *reasonably* be questioned . . .” and enumerates certain examples of when recusal is proper. *See* 207 Pa. Code R.2.11 (emphasis added). Here, the Complainant fails to raise any reasonable questions of the ALJ’s impartiality and his Exception should be dismissed. The Complainant’s baseless allegations of impropriety and the lack of a fair hearing should be rejected. Nothing in the record even remotely suggests that the ALJ engaged in any unethical conduct or “neglected to uphold the mandated neutrality stipulated by law.” (Exception, p. 4.) It appears that the Complainant believes that the ALJ is biased simply because the ALJ ruled against him. However, given the sheer lack of credible evidence presented by the Complainant, compared to the substantial, thorough, and credible evidence presented by Duquesne Light, the ALJ correctly rejected the Complainant’s arguments and ruled that he did not meet his burden of proof. (ID, pp. 7-15.) Because the Complainant has raised no reasonable questions of the ALJ’s impartiality, his Exception should be dismissed.

First, claims that the Complainant previously called for the ALJ to recuse himself are not supported by the record. Here, the Complainant claims that he “timely” and “repeatedly” requested that the ALJ recuse himself from this proceeding due to his alleged bias. (Exception, p. 3.) The Complainant’s assertions that he has raised this bias objection previously have no support in the record for this case. Indeed, at no point during the evidentiary hearing for this matter did the

Complainant raise such an objection, and despite having filed numerous post-hearing motions, including a “Motion for Mistrial and New Hearing,” the Complainant is raising these claims of bias for the first time in his Exception to the ID.

Second, there is no record support for the allegation that the ALJ was “involve[d] in confidential matters during” the hearing held for the above-captioned proceeding. Instead, the hearing transcript indicates that the ALJ afforded the parties the opportunity to discuss settlement prior to the start of the hearing. Although Counsel for Duquesne Light suggested that the ALJ could serve as settlement judge during those settlement discussions, the transcript indicates that the ALJ recessed the hearing at 10:10 AM and left the hearing room to give the parties an opportunity to discuss settlement among themselves and off the record. *See* Tr. 7-9. The record indicates that at 10:29 AM the hearing began, with the ALJ indicating that the parties were unable to reach settlement. Tr. 9. As such, there is no indication from the record in this proceeding that the ALJ ever participated in confidential discussions related to the instant proceeding. Neither does the Complainant’s claim regarding involvement in confidential discussions contain any explanation or factual support of this allegation. Therefore, the Complainant’s assertion that the ALJ should have recused himself on these grounds is unfounded and should be rejected.

Third, the Complainant’s claims that the ALJ “previously served as legal counsel” for him in an ongoing adversary proceeding in the Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania are similarly baseless. True and correct copies of the Docket Sheets for the Complainant’s ongoing bankruptcy proceeding at Docket No. 24-21081-GLT,² as well as the

² On May 3, 2024, the Complainant filed a petition for Chapter 7 bankruptcy in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania at Docket No. 24-21081-GLT (“Bankruptcy Petition”). As of the date of this filing, the Complainant’s Bankruptcy Petition remains active.

related case at Docket No. 24-02040-GLT,³ are attached hereto as **Appendix A**. These Docket Sheets demonstrate that ALJ Johnson has never entered his appearance in the matter cited by the Complainant and further demonstrate that the Complainant is appearing *pro se* in those proceedings and so is not represented by any counsel. *See Appendix A*. The Complainant offers no factual support or explanation for his claim that the ALJ has previously represented him as counsel.⁴ As such, the Complainant's argument that the ALJ is somehow biased because he has served as counsel for the Complainant in an ongoing Bankruptcy Petition or related Adversary Proceeding should be rejected.

Nothing in the record in this proceeding supports the Complainant's contention that the ALJ "neglected to uphold the mandated neutrality stipulated by law" or violated Rule 2.11. (Exception, p. 4.) Because the Complainant has raised no reasonable questions of the ALJ's impartiality, his claim that the ALJ violated Rule 2.11 of the Pennsylvania Code of Judicial Conduct is without merit and his Exception should be dismissed.

Furthermore, the ALJ properly afforded the Complainant due process throughout this proceeding, including during the evidentiary hearing held for this matter. "The Commission, as an administrative body, is bound by the due process provisions of constitutional law and by the principles of common fairness." *Hess v. Pa. PUC*, 107 A.3d 246, 266 (Pa. Cmwlth. 2014) (citations omitted). "Among the requirements of due process are notice and an opportunity to be heard on the issues, to be apprised of the evidence submitted, to cross-examine witnesses, to inspect documents, and to offer evidence in explanation or rebuttal." *Id.* (citations omitted).

Here, the Complainant was provided with notice and an opportunity to be heard on his issues at the August 16, 2023, hearing. Indeed, he had an opportunity to cross-examine the Company's witnesses, review the written testimony and exhibits served by the Company, and offer his own evidence in rebuttal. Additionally, as seen in the ID, the ALJ thoroughly reviewed the Complainant's evidence and arguments. (ID, pp. 7-14.) Ultimately, the ALJ weighed all of the evidence before him and correctly found that the Complainant failed to meet his burden of proof. (ID, p. 14.) Although the Complainant may disagree with the ALJ's decision, the Complainant unquestionably was afforded a full and fair opportunity to present his case.

For these reasons, the Complainant's Exception should be denied.

III. CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, for all the foregoing reasons, as well as those more fully explained in the Initial Decision of Administrative Law Conrad A. Johnson, Duquesne Light Company respectfully requests that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission deny the Exception filed by Todd Elliot Koger and adopt the Initial Decision without modification.
