
On August 2, 2024, Philadelphia Gas Works (PGW or Company) filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) a Petition of Philadelphia Gas Works Requesting a Declaratory Order Regarding Termination of Service For Nonpayment of Undisputed Gas Bills by Landlord Ratepayers (Petition). Specifically, PGW requested that the Commission “remove uncertainty regarding the right and obligation of PGW to take collection action, including terminating gas service, if necessary, for nonpayment of undisputed gas bills for service provided to the properties and residential rental buildings owned, rented and/or managed by ‘landlord ratepayers’ where the landlord ratepayers have a pending, unrelated complaint(s) before the Commission.” The Petition was served on the Commission’s Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement, the Office of Consumer Advocate, the Office of Small Business Advocate, SBG Management Services PA, Inc, and various Landlord Ratepayers.

On August 13, 2024, the Commission issued a Secretarial Letter specifying that answers and petitions to intervene in response to the Petition were to be filed and served on, or before, 30 days after publication of the Petition in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.¹

¹ Publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin was made on August 24, 2024, therefore, any answers and/or petitions are due on, or before, September 23, 2024. No answers and/or petitions have been filed as of the date of this Secretarial Letter.

On September 16, 2024, PGW requested leave to withdraw the Petition as the Company intends to attempt to negotiate an acceptable procedural process with the entity that prompted the Petition. In light of PGW's request, and the fact that this is not a contested proceeding, the Commission grants PGW's request to withdraw the Petition and closes this Docket. Accordingly, the Commission has ceased consideration of the Petition as of the date of this Secretarial Letter.
