ORDER
DIRECTING THE FILING OF A STATUS REPORT

On February 12, 2024, Nieves Abad (“Complainant”) filed a Formal Complaint against PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“Respondent”) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) concerning Respondent utility poles located on his property.

On March 27, 2024, Respondent filed an Answer to the Complaint admitting or denying the averments of the Complaint.

Also on March 27, 2024, Respondent filed Preliminary Objections to the Formal Complaint.

On April 4, 2024, Complainant filed an Answer to the Preliminary Objections.

On May 17, 2024, the Commission issued my Order Granting in Part and Denying in Part the Preliminary Objections.

On June 18, 2024, Complainant filed a Motion to Compel.

On July 18, 2024, a prehearing conference was held with both parties participating.

On August 13, 2024, the Commission issued my Order Clarifying Scope of Proceedings and Granting in Part and Denying in Part Complainant's Motion to Compel.

On September 3, 2024, Complainant filed a Motion for Summary Judgment.

On September 18, 2024, a further prehearing conference was held with both parties participating.

On September 24, 2024, the Commission issued my Order Denying Complainant's Motion for Summary Judgment.

During the September 18, 2024, further prehearing conference, discussions were held between the Parties concerning how this matter should proceed. The parties agreed following the conference: (1) to hold an informal discovery call, and (2) to hold a settlement conference. After these agreements were made, I informed the Parties that I would be issuing an Order that would direct the filing of a Status Report within approximately two months' time. This is that Order.

ORDER

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That on or before **November 22, 2024**, PPL shall file a Status Report, on behalf of both parties, in this proceeding. The Status Report shall indicate whether the parties were able to resolve this case, and if not, propose the next procedural steps to be taken in this proceeding.
