This correspondence is to comply with Ordering Paragraph 7 of the Initial Decision of Administrative Law Judge Katrina L. Dunderdale in the above-referenced matters, which was adopted as modified by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission by Opinion and Order entered on December 21, 2023. That Ordering Paragraph states:

7. That Hidden Valley Utility Services, L.P. shall have the iron/manganese sediment removed from the standpipe storage tank by October 1, 2024 and will notify the Commission's Bureau of Technical Utility Services and all parties herein within thirty (30) days of the removal of the sediment.

A contractor hired by Hidden Valley Utility Services, L.P. removed the iron/manganese sediment from the standpipe storage tank on September 25, 2024.
