Dear Mr. Clearfield:

The Bureau of Audits has reviewed Philadelphia Gas Works' quarterly Distribution System Improvement Charge (DSIC) filing submitted on September 20, 2024. In the filing, the company is not proposing to revise its currently effective DSIC rate of 7.50%.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the DSIC rate for the three-month period of October 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024 is consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, is permitted to become effective as filed.

The DSIC is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter. Any subsequent submissions to the Commission related to this docketed case should reference Docket No. M-2024-3051300.
