The Bureau of Audits has reviewed Duquesne Light Company's proposed Supplement No. 82 to Tariff Electric- PA. P.U.C. No. 25 and the supporting rate computations submitted on September 20, 2024 to become effective on October 1, 2024.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Distribution System Improvement Charge (DSIC) rate for the three-month period of October 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024 is consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, is permitted to increase effective as filed.

The DSIC charge is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
