Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Pennsylvania PUC's Order dated August 1, 2024 and the ALJs' July 1, 2024 Recommended Decision adopted by the Commission in that August 1, 2024 Order, on August 30, 2024, Conneaut Lake Park Water Corporation, Inc. ("CLPWC") submitted a Compliance Report to the Commission with copies to the Joint Petitioners certifying that it has completed the following requirements:

1. The requirements of Paragraph 38;
2. The requirements of Paragraphs 30 - 35, Section B, Customer Service, Items 1 through 6, provided that the required second post card mailing in Paragraph 32 does not need to be satisfied to file the compliance tariff under this Section;
3. The requirements of Paragraphs 46 - 47, Section E, Customer Complaints; and
4. The requirements of Paragraphs 48 - 50, Section F, Regulatory Compliance.

Under the Order and Recommended Decision, the Joint Petitioners had thirty (30) days to submit any responsive comments regarding the Compliance Report to CLPWC and this Commission. The thirtieth day following the submission of the Compliance Report by CLPWC was September 30, 2024. No responsive comments were received by CLPWC as of September 30, 2024, and a review of the docket reflects that no responsive comments were filed with the Commission as of that date.

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Under the Recommended Decision adopted by the Commission, if no comments are submitted, any claims relating to the status of the Company's compliance with the above referenced paragraphs is waived.

Given that CLPWC has submitted a Compliance Report certifying compliance and that no responsive comments have been submitted, CLPWA respectfully requests that the Commission enter a Final Commission Order that deems the Compliance Report to be complete and allows CLPWC to submit its compliance filing implementing the tariff changes in accordance with the Settlement.

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
