Dear Attorney Ryan:

On September 5, 2024, UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division (the Company) filed Supplement No. 52 to UGI Gas – Pa. P.U.C. No. 7 to become effective on November 4, 2024. The supplement was filed in compliance with the Commission’s Order entered October 4, 2019, approving the Settlement in the Company’s base rate case at Docket No. R-2018-3006814, and reflects the end of the Rule 5.8 – Pilot Growth Extension Tariff (GET Gas) Rider pilot program. The GET Gas pilot program will end on November 4, 2024. The proposed supplement appropriately reflects the end of the pilot program to help make it clear to customers and interested stakeholders that the pilot program has ended and that the GET Gas pilot program terms and conditions are no longer active.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, Supplement No. 52 to UGI Gas – Pa. P.U.C. No. 7 is effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page of the supplement. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
