The deadline for signing up for the public input hearing is noon, October 4, 2024.

If you intend to offer any exhibits at the public input hearing, you must email your proposed exhibit(s) to the legal assistant at pmcneal@pa.gov by October 4, 2024.

In your email, you must copy all individuals listed in the "full service list" in the attached parties' list. Failure to comply with these instructions may result in you not being allowed to present your proposed exhibit(s). Proposed video evidence must be submitted in an mp4 format and cannot exceed 2MB. Proposed video evidence that does not meet these criteria will not be permitted.
