TO ALL PARTIES:

By Secretarial Letter dated August 12, 2024, the Commission issued the Initial Decision of Special Agent Michael J. Mroczka in this matter. Exceptions were due within twenty days of that letter (i.e., on or before Monday, September 2, 2024<sup>1</sup>) and Replies to Exceptions were due within ten days after that date (i.e., on or before Thursday, September 12, 2024).

On September 10, 2024, the Commission received a Petition for Extension of Time to File Exceptions to the Initial Decision (Petition) from James Roberts (Complainant). In the Petition, the Complainant stated that he received the Initial Decision many days later, by regular mail, as he is not signed up for eService with the Commission. Upon further review, there was no certificate of service or other indication that PPL Electric Utilities (PPL) was served with the Petition. To cure this procedural defect, PPL was served with the Petition by Secretarial Letter dated October 2, 2024, to constitute service for purposes of 52 Pa. Code § 5.533.

The Commission's Regulation at 52 Pa. Code § 1.15 permits the Commission to grant an extension of time for good cause shown before or after the pertinent time period has expired. The Commission finds that the Complainant has established good cause for the requested extension of time. As a result, the Commission will extend the period for filing Exceptions; Exceptions will be due no later than twenty (20) days from the date of this Secretarial Letter. Accordingly, the new deadline for filing Replies to Exceptions shall be ten (10) days from the date that Exceptions are due.

<sup>1</sup> The twenty-day period ended on September 1, 2024, which was a Sunday. Therefore, Exceptions were due on or before the next business day, Monday, September 2, 2024.
