Please note that it is only as of today that I learned from Bonnie in the Secretary's Bureau as to precisely what to do on this end. After checking on things on her end, she did inform me that it is quite possibly the case that my previous letter was never received.

As instructed at that time, the previous letter was sent to a post office box in Harrisburg. Bonnie pointed out that there apparently have been problems with the mail service to that address.

The letter sent last month was meant to inform the Commission of the desire to exercise our right to appeal the initial decision as well as to request not only an extension but also much-needed assistance with the exceptions filings.

Not for lack of trying, but I have yet to find an agency or network that can assist citizens who are disadvantaged and who have limited abilities. If your commission has such a department, please refer this matter to it. Otherwise, someone may need to discuss the hurdles present in this stage of the process with me.

The previous letter did detail the effort put in thus far on this process. A plea for help was once well-received but ultimately was revoked at the very last minute.
