Application of Verizon North, LLC for approval of the alteration of the public crossing where SR 0031 (Main Street) crosses, at grade, a single track owned by CSX Transportation, Inc. (DOT 145 162 E) by the installation of an aerial fiber optic cable, located in the Borough of Somerset, Somerset County

To Whom It May Concern:

By Secretarial Letter dated October 5, 2022, the Commission approved the application of Verizon North, LLC for the installation of a new aerial communication fiber where State Route 0031 (Main Street) crosses, at grade, track of CSX Transportation, Inc in the Borough of Somerset, Somerset County. All work at the subject crossing was to be completed on or before October 31, 2023.

By letter-petition received on September 19, 2024, Verizon North, LLC requested the Commission extend the completion date two (2) years to October 31, 2025, due to ongoing permitting issues.

We have carefully reviewed the record in this proceeding and will grant Verizon North, LLC's letter-petition for an extension of time to October 31, 2025.

THEREFORE:

The letter-petition received September 19, 2024, from Verizon North, LLC be and is hereby granted to the extent herein directed:

1. Paragraph 8 of our Secretarial Letter dated October 5, 2022, which reads as follows, to wit:

“8. The alteration of the crossing be completed on or before October 31, 2023, and that on or before said date Verizon North, LLC report, in writing, the date of actual completion of the work to this Commission and certify to the parties of record and this Commission that the work has been satisfactorily completed in accordance with the approved sketch plans and this Secretarial Letter.”

be and is hereby modified to read:

8. The alteration of the crossing be completed on or before October 31, 2025, and that on or before said date Verizon North, LLC report, in writing, the date of actual completion of the work to this Commission and certify to the parties of record and this Commission that the work has been satisfactorily completed in accordance with the approved sketch plans and this Secretarial Letter

2. In all respects not inconsistent herewith, our Secretarial Letter dated October 5, 2022, remain in full force and effect.

The Parties are reminded that failure to comply with this or any Order or Secretarial Letter in this proceeding may result in an enforcement action seeking civil penalties and/or other sanctions pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 3301.



If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to file by overnight delivery to ensure the timely filing of your submission. There are certain filings that cannot be eFiled, such as filings containing confidential or proprietary material. These must be submitted to the Secretary by overnight delivery, priority, or certified mail to allow tracking of your filing.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.31 and 5.44, file a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The Petition shall be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission or sent to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, and must be filed within twenty (20) days, or if no timely request is made, the action will be deemed to be a final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request; (2) the case docket number (it is provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter); (3) the party on whose behalf the petition is made; (4) a Certificate of Service on the other parties of record; and (5) a Verification with original signature in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36.
