ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO ADMIT ON THE RECORD DATA REQUEST

This Order is issued pursuant to the authority granted to Presiding Officers under the Commission’s regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.483.

On May 31, 2024, UGI Utilities, Inc. – Electric Division (“UGI”), filed the Petition of UGI Utilities, Inc. – Electric Division for Approval of a Default Service Plan for the Period June 1, 2025 through May 31, 2029 (“Petition”), along with direct testimony of prospective witnesses and related documents. UGI also requested approval of Associated Potential Transactions with Affiliated Entities.

The Petition was published in the June 22, 2024, version of the Pennsylvania Bulletin with a Protest, Intervention, and Answer deadline of July 12, 2024. Answers were filed against the Petition by the Office of Consumer Advocate (“OCA”) and the Office of Small Business Advocate (“OSBA”), and a Formal Complaint against the Petition was filed by Penn Renewables, LLC (“Penn”).

The evidentiary hearing concerning the Petition was held on October 1, 2024. UGI, OCA, OSBA, and Penn participated in the hearing. The pre-submitted testimonies and exhibits of

the Parties were moved and admitted into the record during the hearing. Cross-examination was conducted of two UGI witnesses and one Penn witness.

During the cross-examination of one of UGI's witnesses, Penn made an on the record data request, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.351, requesting that UGI provide an updated discovery response for Penn Renewables discovery question Set III, No. 8 to UGI Electric. UGI did not object to the request and agreed to provide an updated exhibit within one week of the conclusion of the hearing.

On October 8, 2024, UGI filed a Motion to Admit on the Record Data Request ("Motion"). The Motion moved for the admission of "UGI Electric Updated Response to Penn Renewables Set III, Question 8," attached as Appendix A to the Motion, into the record in this proceeding. By email, the undersigned Presiding Officers directed the Parties to file objections, if any, to the Motion by 4:00 p.m. October 9, 2024. No party objected to the Motion by this deadline.

Given that "UGI Electric Updated Response to Penn Renewables Set III, Question 8," is responsive to the on the record data request made at the October 1, 2024, hearing, and given that no Party objected to its admission, the following Order will be adopted:

ORDER

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That UGI Utilities, Inc. – Electric Division's Motion to Admit on the Record Data Request, filed on October 8, 2024, is granted.

2. That “UGI Electric Updated Response to Penn Renewables Set III, Question 8,” attached as Appendix A to the Motion, is admitted into the record in this proceeding.
