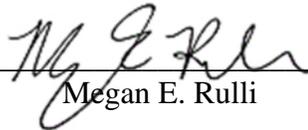

**STATUS REPORT OF DUQUESNE LIGHT COMPANY**


TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE MARY D. LONG:

Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light” or the “Company”) submits the following Status Report, pursuant to the Interim Order Granting Continuance dated September 26, 2024, entered in this proceeding (“Interim Order”). The Interim Order required the parties to confer and agree on at least three alternate hearing dates when both Parties are available for hearing and for Duquesne Light to file a status report on or before October 15, 2024, which reports the hearing dates agreed upon by the parties. Via email with the parties on October 16, 2024, Administrative Law Judge Mary D. Long granted Duquesne Light additional time to file the instant status report. Counsel for Duquesne Light has been in contact with the Complainant, Ms. Valen Tasser, to discuss the directives of the Interim Order. The Parties jointly identified the following dates for a rescheduled evidentiary hearing:

- January 8, 2025 – 10:00 AM or 1:00 PM start time.
- January 15, 2025 – 10:00 AM or 1:00 PM start time.
- January 16, 2025 – 2:00 PM start time.
