

1. Reference Application, Section 1.b, Registered Agent – Applicant failed to provide a telephone number for the applicant’s registered agent. Please provide an updated Application page with the appropriate corrections.
2. Reference Application, Section 4.a, Present Operations – Applicant indicated that it currently operates within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as a broker/marketer engaged in the business of supplying natural gas services. Please provide details of all natural gas broker/marketer operations which occurred within Pennsylvania, including the types of brokering services provided, the number of customers serviced, and the list of NGS suppliers for which applicant has arranged contracts.
3. Reference Application, Section 5.c, Customer/Regulatory/Prosecutory Actions – Applicant failed to list the complaint filed against it with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, at Case Record 19-2050-GE-CSS. Please file an updated Application page with the requested information.
4. Reference Application, Section 7.b, Financial Fitness – Applicant failed to provide its bank statements as mentioned in its confidential filing. Please provide the missing documentation.
5. Reference Application, Section 8.e, Technical Fitness – Applicant failed to provide a detailed professional resume for Ryan Boucher, to include detailed descriptions on all experience and activities including date ranges. Please provide the missing documentation.
6. Reference Application, Section 12, Notarized Proofs – Applicant provided unacceptable notarized Proofs of Publication showing ads that were run during the 2019 calendar year. Applicant must provide notarized Proofs of Publication for the Erie Times-News, the Harrisburg Patriot-News, the Philadelphia Daily News or Philadelphia Inquirer, the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette, the Scranton Times-Tribune, the Williamsport Sun-Gazette, and the Johnstown Tribune-Democrat using the template ads from the most recent NGS application package.
