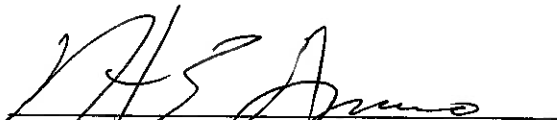

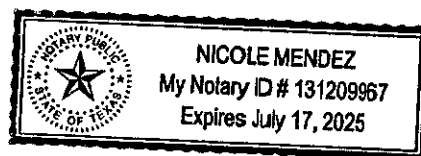

Dear Customer,

Tomorrow Energy Corp (“Tomorrow Energy”) has appreciated the opportunity to serve as the Electric Generation Supplier (“Supplier”) for your «UtilityLongName» account. However, in accordance with your terms and conditions, we are writing to let you know that Tomorrow Energy will assign your electric supply service to Respond Power, LLC d/b/a Major Energy (“Major Energy”), another Supplier licensed by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. This change will take effect approximately 30 days after the date of this assignment notice, on approximately «Reassignment_Date». After such date Major Energy will provide your electric supply service.

Major Energy is run by an experienced team of energy experts with decades of retail energy supply and utility experience. Major Energy team’s experience in deregulated energy markets enables them to offer competitive prices and friendly customer service.

No action is required on your part when this transfer occurs. Major Energy will honor your current agreement in place with Tomorrow Energy and there will be no changes to the existing terms or conditions through to the expiration of the duration of your current contract. This transfer will not cause an interruption of your electric supply services and you should continue to pay your «UtilityLongName» bill as normal and call «UtilityLongName» in case of an outage or emergency just as you do today. As the date of this notice, your current rate with Tomorrow Energy is \$«Rate»/kWh or «RateCents» cents/kWh). You may decline to be assigned to Major Energy in accordance with the cancellation provisions in your current contract with Tomorrow Energy by contacting Tomorrow Energy at the telephone number below. If you decide to not have your contract assigned, you will be returned to your local electric distribution company default service unless you enroll with Major Energy or another supplier. The same quality support and service that you are used to with Tomorrow Energy will continue with Major Energy.

As set forth in your current contract with Tomorrow Energy, if you have a fixed rate plan with Tomorrow Energy, your service will continue with the same fixed rate and terms until the end of your contract duration or upon cancellation of your supply service. Thereafter, you will receive information regarding your renewal options. You may also contact Major Energy directly to see what other options are available to you, including new options with Major Energy when your contract expires.

Frequently Asked Questions

Will my electric supply service be cut off?

No, this transfer will not cause an interruption of your electric supply services and you should continue to pay your «UtilityLongName» bill as normal.

Who do I call in case of a power outage or emergency?

Your Utility has not changed; you should call «UtilityLongName» for any outage or emergency just as you do today.

Will my current rate change?

If you have a fixed rate plan with Tomorrow Energy, your service will continue with the same fixed rate until the end of your current contract term or upon cancellation of service. If you are currently served under a variable rate with Tomorrow Energy, your service will continue under a variable rate plan. After «Last_Date_to_Call» you may also contact Major Energy directly to see what other options are available when your contract expires.

Will my meter read cycle or utility charges change?

No, you will continue to receive your bill from «UtilityLongName» as you always have. The only change is that Major Energy will now be listed as the Supplier.

What will happen to my contract / agreement with Tomorrow Energy?

Contract assignment is allowed per the terms and conditions of your Tomorrow Energy agreement. Major Energy will honor your current agreements with Tomorrow Energy, so no changes will occur with their terms or conditions until the contract end date. If you are a Tomorrow Energy customer on a Variable Rate Plan, your service will continue on a variable rate plan. You will also be eligible to renew to a fixed rate plan with Major Energy.

My contract was about to expire with Tomorrow Energy, what does this mean for me?

If the contract expires before the effective date of your transfer, your service will continue under the Tomorrow Energy variable rate unless you choose a new fixed rate from Major Energy. If your contract expires after the effective date of your transfer, contact Major Energy for their current plan offerings.

Do I need to do anything to switch to Major Energy?

No, you will not need to do anything. We will make this transition as smooth as possible for you. In accordance with your current contract with Tomorrow Energy, we are assigning your electric supply service to Major Energy, another Supplier licensed by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

When can I expect Major Energy to become my official Supplier?

Tomorrow Energy will assign your electric supply service to Major Energy, another Supplier licensed by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, effective on approximately «Reassignment_Date».

Will I need to sign up with Major Energy or go through a credit check again?

No, Major Energy welcomes you as their customer in a clear and hassle-free way.

How will I know when I have started services with Major Energy?

Major Energy will appear as your Supplier in the Energy Supply portion of your utility bill.

Will I be able to opt out of the switch to Major Energy?

You can opt out of the switch to Major Energy by requesting to drop to «UtilityLongName» or switch to another Supplier while active with Tomorrow Energy.

NOTICE TO LICENSED ELECTRICITY PROVIDERS

Availability of Confidential Treatment for Information Provided in Quarterly and Annual Reports

Note that pursuant to 52 PA Code § 54.39(d) these annual and quarterly reports “will be made available for public review upon request to the Commission subject to any rulings on confidentiality made by the Commission.” However, the Commission has issued a general ruling that the total amount of gross receipts that licensed EGSs are required to report pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 54.39(b)(2) is considered proprietary and shall not be released to the public. See Petitions of Exelon Energy; Reliant Energy Retail, Inc.; and Statoil Energy Services, Inc for Protective Order, Order entered July 20, 2000 at Docket Nos. P-00991752; P-00991753; P-00991755, p. 5. Updates to tax information requested in the application form; the total amount of electricity sold (kWh); and, the percentage of total electricity supplied by each energy source remain available for public review. Confidential treatment of this information may be requested in accordance with established Commission procedures. See also 52 Pa. Code § 5.423.

To request confidential treatment of submitted information, a company must:

- (a) indicate clearly in its transmittal letter that the filing contains proprietary information;
- (b) explain briefly why the information should be treated as confidential; and,
- (c) supply two versions of the filing: one version of the report with confidential data redacted and one version of the proprietary report. The proprietary version must be clearly marked “Confidential.” The Secretary’s Bureau and the Bureau of Fixed Utility Services will maintain copies of each type of filing accordingly.

Pending Commission review of a request for confidential treatment and upon its approval, information designated as proprietary will not be made available for public review. However, if any member of the public, the Office of Consumer Advocate or the Office of Small Business Advocate requests to examine the propriety information, or if the Commission’s Office of Special Assistants or Bureau of Investigation & Enforcement believes that proprietary claim is frivolous or otherwise not justified, the Secretary’s Bureau will issue a Secretarial Letter directing the company to file within 14 days a petition for protective order pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.423. During the 14-day period, the Commission will continue to honor the proprietary claim. Absent the timely filing of such a petition, the proprietary information claim will be deemed to have been waived.

While the Commission is considering whether to grant a petition for protective order, the company’s proprietary information claim will be honored unless a proceeding has been initiated to challenge the filing. In that event, the provisions of 52 Pa. Code § 5.423(b)(4) would apply. This provision requires the company to disclose the proprietary information to a party involved in the proceeding if the party "agrees to treat the information as if it were covered by a protective order until the presiding officer or the Commission issues the order or determines that issuance of the order would not be appropriate.”
