RE: Electric Generation Supplier License Application

Dear Ms. Gurnett:

On July 16, 2024, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) received Enel X Advisory Services USA, LLC's Application for an Electric Generation Supplier (EGS) license. On September 19, 2024, the Commission notified Enel X Advisory Services USA, LLC through a Secretarial Letter that its EGS license Application was not properly completed and contained deficiencies that must be corrected and submitted within 20 days. The Secretarial Letter stated that failure to timely respond would result in the Application being deemed rejected¹ and the docket closed. To date, a corrected and complete Application has not been received by the Commission's Secretary's Bureau.

Given Enel X Advisory Services USA, LLC's failure to correct the deficiencies and provide a complete EGS license Application, the Commission deems Enel X Advisory Services USA, LLC's EGS license Application incomplete and therefore it is rejected without prejudice. The Application fee is a processing fee and NOT refundable.

Please be advised that if Enel X Advisory Services USA, LLC were to resubmit an Application for an EGS license, it must file a complete EGS license Application and submit a filing fee of \$350.
