**INTERIM ORDER
DIRECTING PARTIES TO FILE STATUS REPORT**

There is significant procedural history in this matter, and this Order does not address all of it.

Most recently, on June 5, 2024, I issued an Interim Order granting in part and denying in part the Company’s Motion for Summary Judgment.

On June 6, 2024, the Commission issued a Prehearing Order which scheduled a telephonic hearing for July 31, 2024.

On July 19, 2024, the Complainant sent a letter requesting to reschedule the hearing on July 31, 2024, due to a conflict.

On July 26, 2024, a Further Call-In Telephonic Hearing Notice was issued rescheduling the hearing initially scheduled for July 31, 2024, to September 12, 2024.

On August 22, 2024, I issued an Interim Order rescheduling the evidentiary hearing scheduled for July 31, 2024, to September 12, 2024.

On September 9, 2024, the Company filed a Motion to Continue the hearing (Motion). In its Motion, it explained that on September 6, 2024, it contacted Complainant via e-

mail and telephone to discuss the continuance request. It noted that Complainant was agreeable to a continuance of the hearing in this matter to engage in further settlement discussions. The Company further averred that the parties were actively working together towards resolution of the Complaint and required some additional time. As such, the Company requested that the hearing scheduled for September 12, 2024, be rescheduled to a later date if the parties were unable to resolve the Complaint. The Company proposed that the parties submit a joint status report on October 21, 2024, to provide an update on settlement progress, noting the Complainant agreed to this proposal.

On September 9, 2024, the Commission issued a Hearing Cancellation Notice, cancelling the hearing for September 12, 2024.

On October 8, 2024, I issued an Interim Order directing the parties to file a status report by October 21, 2024.

On October 21, 2024, the Company filed a status report advising the parties were actively working toward resolution of the Complaint and explaining its position that settlement of this matter is possible. The Company requested it be permitted to file an updated status report on November 15, 2024.

On October 23, 2023, I received a status report from Complainant via first class mail. It does not appear that it was filed with the Commission. Therefore, I have attached it to this Order as Attachment A so it is part of the record. In her status report, Complainant explains she has had communication with the Company's counsel and is waiting on calls back from other Company representatives. She avers she is confident that the parties will be able to find solutions to resolve her Complaint.

It is reasonable to allow the parties additional time to explore possible settlement of this matter, especially because both parties agree that their discussions have been productive and settlement is possible, if not likely.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the parties shall file a status report on or before November 15, 2024.
