**PREHEARING MEMORANDUM
OF THE OFFICE OF SMALL BUSINESS ADVOCATE**

I. INTRODUCTION

The Office of Small Business Advocate (“OSBA”) is authorized to represent the interests of small business customers of utility services before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) pursuant to the provisions of the Small Business Advocate Act, Act 181 of 1988, 73 P.S. §§ 399.41 – 399.50 (“the Act”). In order to discharge this statutory duty, the Small Business Advocate deems it necessary to participate as a party to these proceedings. II. FILING BACKGROUND

On July 23, 2024, The York Water Company (“York Water” or the “Company”) filed a Petition for Approval of a Lead Service Line Replacement (“LSLR”) Program (“Petition”) with the Commission.

The OSBA filed a Notice of Intervention on August 7, 2024.

III. IDENTIFICATION OF ISSUES

The OSBA will participate in this proceeding to assure that the interests of York Water’s small business customers are adequately represented and protected.

At the time of this writing, the OSBA is reviewing the materials submitted by the Company. Nevertheless, the OSBA has identified the following list of issues that it will evaluate in this proceeding:

1. Whether the Company’s proposed annual caps on the number of service lines replaced and the annual investment in lead service line replacements are reasonable.
2. Whether the Company’s proposal for prioritizing LSLR projects is reasonable and appropriate.

The OSBA reserves the right to pursue additional issues that may arise throughout this proceeding.

IV. SERVICE OF DOCUMENTS
