Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On September 26, 2024, Administrative Law Judge John M. Coogan (the “ALJ”) issued an Initial Decision (“ID”) dismissing the above-captioned Formal Complaint. In the Secretarial Letter accompanying the ID, Exceptions to the ID were due within 20 days, or by October 16, 2024. Replies to any Exceptions were due within 10 days of the Exceptions due date, or by October 28, 2024. UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division (“UGI Gas” or the “Company”) did not file Exceptions to the ID, nor was the Company served with Exceptions by Jennifer Patora (“Complainant”) by the October 16, 2024 due date.<sup>1</sup>

On November 4, 2024, UGI Gas became aware that the Complainant had filed Exceptions through a review of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s (“Commission”) electronic docket for the Formal Complaint. The Complainant’s Exceptions were dated October 16, 2024, and appear to have been posted to the Commission’s electronic docket in the above-referenced proceeding on October 17, 2024. However, as UGI Gas was never served with the Complainant’s Exceptions, UGI Gas did not submit Replies to the Complainant’s Exceptions by the October 28, 2024 due date.


