

4. On May 30, 2024, the PaPUC's Secretary granted the Petition, and advised Hudson that it had until June 12, 2024, to file any responsive pleading to the Formal Complaint.

5. On June 6, 2024, Hudson filed with the PaPUC a Request for Continuance of Hearing in order for it to complete its investigation and to attempt informal resolution of this matter. In an Interim Order dated June 10, 2024, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Alphonso Arnold III ("ALJ") granted Hudson's request for a continuance of the previously scheduled evidentiary hearing.

6. On June 12, 2024, the Company filed an Answer and New Matter to the Formal Complaint denying the material allegations contained therein and requesting that the Formal Complaint be dismissed.

7. Chief ALJ Charles E. Rainey, Jr. issued an Interim Order dated July 25, 2024, directing (i) Hudson and the Complainant to attempt to settle this matter and (ii) Hudson to file a short report with the mediator, Terri-Lee Rhoades, containing, among other things, whether the Parties consent to have this case set for mediation by the mediation staff of the Commission. The Parties consented to mediation and to date, Hudson has filed two Status Reports with the Mediator.

8. The Company certifies that the parties entered into settlement discussions and have successfully achieved a mutually satisfactory resolution of the case. All issues raised in the Formal Complaint have been resolved, and the Complainant has indicated that it is satisfied and will not pursue the Complaint further.


9. The Complainant has authorized the Company to file this Certificate of Satisfaction.


