3. Verizon Pennsylvania LLC requests permission to place an aerial fiber optic cable in the City of Chester, Delaware County. **Projected Start Date for this project is January 1, 2025.**

4. The proposed construction will involve a placement of an aerial innerduct with fiber optic cable attached to existing Verizon poles (Exhibit A)

5. The municipalities and property owners concerned in, or affected by, the crossing alterations are in Exhibit "B".

6. The motoring public and railroad traffic will not be impacted. Verizon Pennsylvania LLC will use normal construction procedures. Normal procedures will be followed including the use of flagmen to maintain normal flow of traffic.

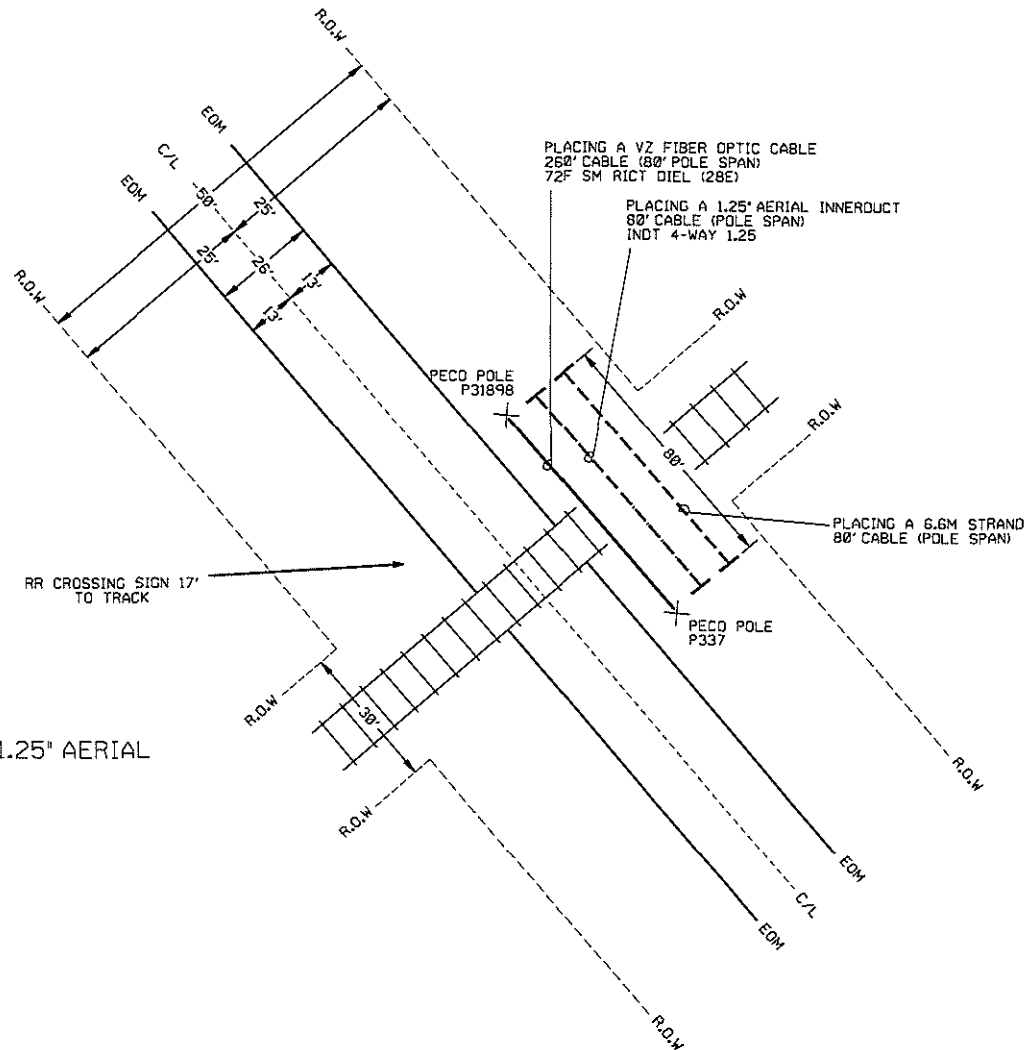

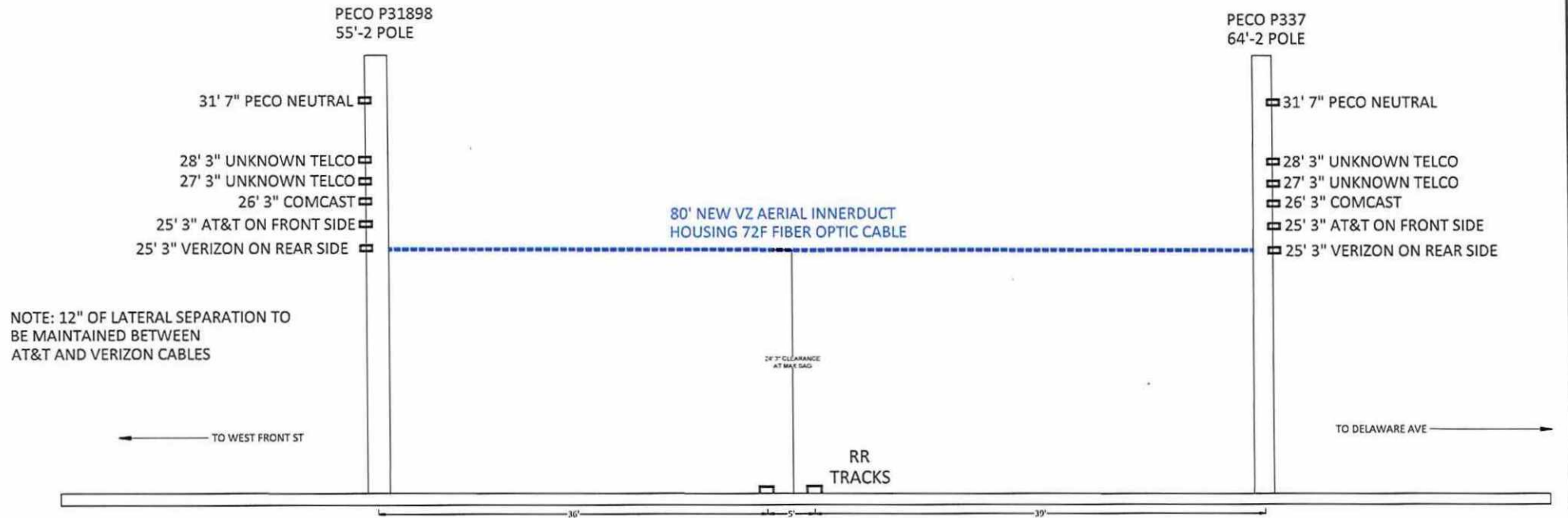


NEW 72F CABLE BEING PLACED WITH NEW 1.25" AERIAL
