INTRODUCTION

Complainant, Shasta-Patrice: Brown, a living soul, hereby humbly and respectfully submits this Judicial Notice to Your Honor to establish jurisdictional challenges, define critical terms, assert divine rights endowed by Elohim God, and request discovery. Complainant also seeks relief for PECO's unauthorized Social Security number use, deceptive practices, and ultra vires actions, violating rights and causing harm.

DEFINITIONS

Using Ballentine's Law Dictionary (1948), Bouvier's Law Dictionary, and Black's Law Dictionary:

1. Person: Artificial entity, not a natural being (Ballentine's).
2. Individual: Single human being (Bouvier).
3. Natural Person: Human being, opposed to artificial person (Black's).
4. Citizen: Member of a state or nation (Bouvier).
5. Human Being: Not applicable to Complainant, a living soul.
6. Resident (Trust Res): Beneficiary of a trust residence, not necessarily a physical dweller (Trust Res definitions).

7. Contract: Agreement between parties creating obligations (Black's), not applicable to Complainant.
8. Nisi Prius: Under contract; implying a burden of proof on the party claiming jurisdiction (Bouvier).
9. Inhabitant: One dwelling within jurisdiction.
10. Public Utility: Service provider regulated by government
11. Ultra Vires: Actions beyond authority.

DIVINE RIGHTS

Complainant asserts divine rights endowed by Elohim God, superseding statutory laws.

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

Complainant reserves all rights, remedies, and defenses (UCC 1-308).

FOUNDATION

1. United States Constitution, Articles IX and X.
2. Universal Declaration of Human Rights, Article 6.
3. Birth Certificate [Number].
4. Complainant's Affidavit of Truth.

JURISDICTIONAL CHALLENGE

PUC lacks jurisdiction, (66 Pa.C.S. § 3101) acting nisi prius (under contract), and bears the burden of proof. It has no authority to adjudicate matters beyond its statutory scope. (Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(1)).

EQUITABLE INTEREST

Complainant has equitable interest due to:

1. Unjust enrichment (PECO's unauthorized SSN use).
2. Ultra vires actions.
3. Lack of proper authorization.

CONTRACT BETWEEN GSA AND PECO

Complainant benefits from contract between General Services Administration (GSA). The contract number is GS-00P-16-BSD-1212.

ORIGINAL PROMISSORY NOTE

Complainant did not abandon original promissory note (application for services) or her rights, title, or interest.

FRAUD AND MISREPRESENTATION

PECO acted under false and misleading practices, (73 Pa.C.S. § 201-2), fraud in factum, unjust enrichment and theft by deception. (18 Pa.C.S. § 3921).

REQUEST FOR RELIEF

Complainant humbly requests that your Honorable Commission awards:

1. Compensatory relief
2. Injunctive relief
3. Statutory relief
4. Declaratory relief
5. Forensic audit to determine damages
6. Require PECO to update their records to show the true party of interest and credit the account appropriately.
7. Make the proper referral to a court of equity where necessary and appropriate.


REQUEST FOR DISCOVERY

 - b. Debit and credit entries.


