- 2) Reference Application – Paragraphs 5, and 9. These sections state that the delivery point of Willow Grove has not been used and has not generated any revenue in the past approximately 13 years. Does the company incur any expenses in maintaining this delivery point? If so, please provide the annual cost for the last 5 years.

RESPONSE: The Company does not currently incur expense in maintaining this delivery point. Non-pipeline facilities such as storage tanks, require ongoing cleaning, inspection, repair and maintenance expenses. Inspections per tank can range from \$4,000-\$9,000 and are performed approximately every 5-10 years. When deliveries were made to the Willow Grove destination, approximately 8 tanks were utilized, depending on demand. Maintenance and repairs after an inspection (where indicated) are often \$25,000 per tank. The last year in which such expenses were incurred was 2019. The Company incurred the following expenses in 2019:

Tank 3 - \$6,000 inspection

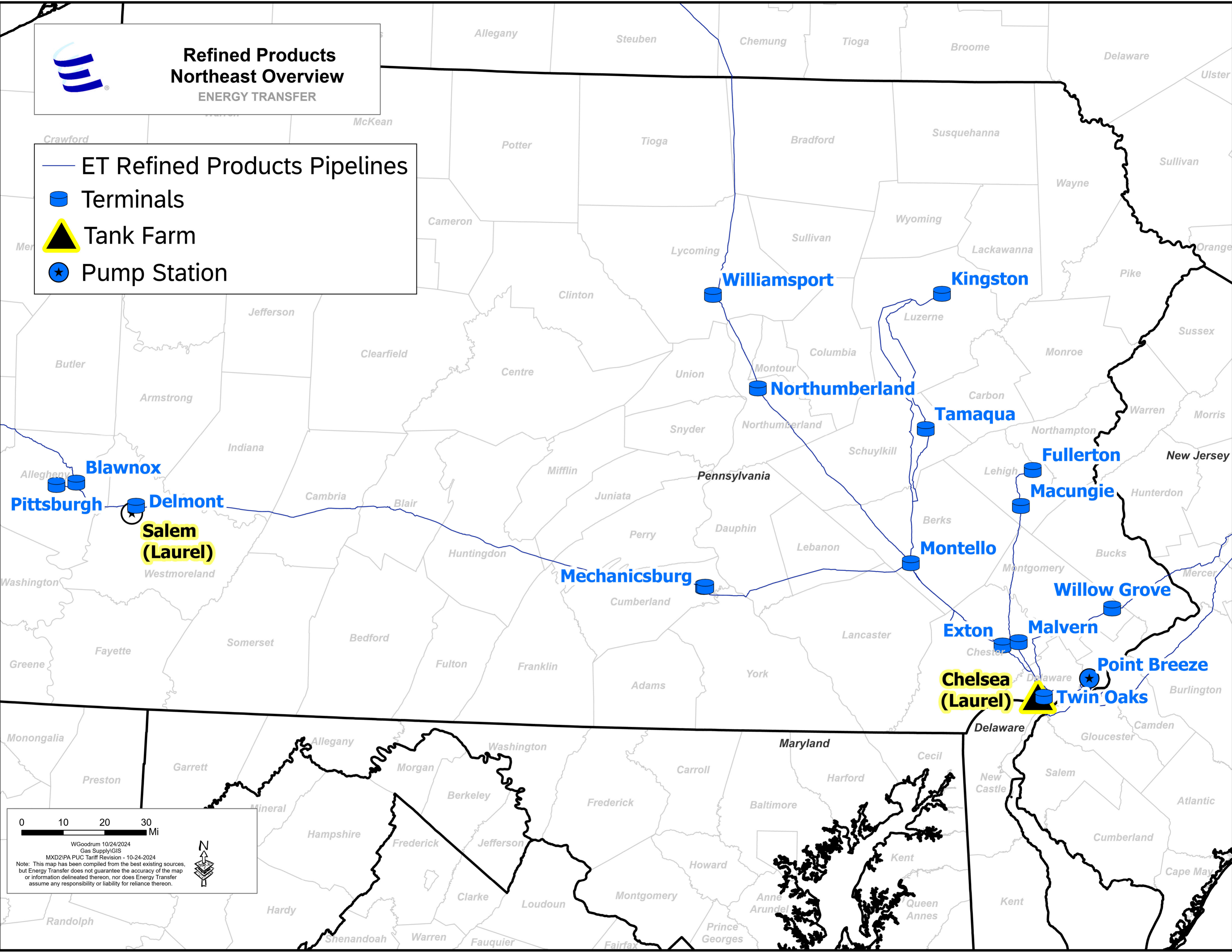
