As requested by the deficiency letter dated 10/25/2024, below please find the responses to the additional data request.

Docket No. A-2024-3050636 Utiliz Servies, LLC Data Requests

- 1. Reference Application, Section 5.a, b, and c. Compliance, Applicant stated: “The applicant has no proceedings to list” in response to each of the three compliance related sections (5.a, b, and c.). There appear to be numerous filings in at least one jurisdiction against the applicant and/or people named in the application. Of note is a proceeding filed by the Office of Education, Outreach, and Enforcement of the Connecticut Public Utilities Regulatory Authority at Docket Nos. 22-05-17, and 14- 03-03. If this case involves either the applicant and/or people listed in the application, please resubmit the application with Section 5-a, b, and c fully disclosed. Applicants must list and identify all such proceedings (active or closed within the last five years), by name, subject and citation; whether before an administrative body or in a judicial forum. Provide a statement as to the resolution or present status of any such proceedings listed.**

Utiliz Services was granted an electricity aggregator license in the state of Connecticut in July of 2022, but ultimately asked PURA to withdraw its license. This was done voluntarily by Utiliz Services, LLC, and the license was quickly terminated. The reason for the change is that Connecticut defined a broker differently than other states, and it was determined that Utiliz Services' business methods did not qualify as an “Aggregator” under Connecticut law, but rather would be classified as an “Agent” of a retail supplier, for which no license is available in Connecticut.

The proceeding referenced was brought against Major Energy, not Utiliz Services, LLC. Because Utiliz Services was not a party to that proceeding, it does not have direct personal knowledge of the issues therein. To the best of Applicant's knowledge, the proceeding alleged that Major Energy violated Connecticut rules with regard to customers,
