2.) Question # 5 of the Verified Statement.

Please review the requirements of the following chapters of 52 Pa Code and provide a compliant plan for drivers that demonstrates compliance with the below cited statutes.

A. 52 Pa Code § 37.204, 49 CFR 391.25 - Driver history (frequency of driver license check).

- We will run driver's license checks and motor vehicle records once per year for every driver covering the preceding 12 months where drivers held commercial vehicle operator's licenses

B. 52 Pa Code § 31.134 - Criminal history. (b) (frequency of record check),

- We will run criminal background checks through the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania every 2 years.

(c) Disqualification

- We will disqualify persons for employment if they are convicted of felonies or misdemeanors that might adversely reflect that person's ability to provide service safely and legally.

(d) Record retention.

- We will retain hard copy as well as electronic file records from each employee for at least 3 years.

3.) Question #7 of the Verified Statement.

A. Is it your procedure to conduct a pre/post trip inspection on the vehicle(s)?

- Crew leaders will fill out a inspection checklist every morning before departing.

B. If so, what will this inspection involve?

- Inspection will involve checking fuel levels, windshield wipers/fluid, insurance and registration cards, mirrors tightened and not cracked, exterior lights, license plate visible, no warning lights on dash, horn functioning, emergency triangles present, fire extinguisher secure and full, cargo box is clean and dry, tires are inflated and not damaged or have low tread, oil is above lower indicator on dip stick, coolant is above low line on reservoir, liftgate and cargo door functioning properly.

4.) Statement of Financial Position (balance Sheet).

A. The information provided is also to be strictly limited to assets and debts of the applicant. Provide verifiable proof of ownership of the vehicle listed, with a copy of the registration and/or title in the name of the applicant (ROADRUNNER MOVING LLC).


