In response to your most recent letter on our PA Motor Carrier Authority request for Docket # A-2024-3052218, below are the responses to your questions.

Q1-We have filed for a USDOT Number and were given 4329909. We are currently waiting for the USDOT to finalize the paperwork and send us confirmation.

Q2-We intend to use our 8 drivers that we have and during the peak season we may bring on 1-2 drivers depending on how busy we are. The crew that we have now will provide us with the opportunity to service our territory efficiently and effectively.

a. Hiring Standards:

b. Our hiring standards follow Atlas van lines hiring standards as well as the Pennsylvania Code. All contract carriers must be at least 21 years of age, must be able to pass a background check, have a clean driving record, valid driver's license, road test, and must pass a pre-employment screening.

d. System for conducting criminal background checks:

e. For criminal background checks we use a third-party company, Clearstar. They conduct a local and a national criminal background check for every applicant. The background check includes a multistate criminal record locator as well as a nationwide database with source search validation and review of the US Department of Justice National sex offender public website.

f. Driver Training Program:

1. Our driver training program educates the drivers on company policies as well as Atlas van line policies, Dot regulations, hours of service, emergency procedures, accident protocols, pre-trip inspection training. We also have our drivers complete periodic training through Infint-I Training platform that must be completed within 30 days, or they will be put on a safety suspension.

g. System for conducting driver license checks:


- i. We use HireRight to conduct driver license checks that verify the license status as well violations. Yearly we obtain a driver history check for each contract carrier, and we keep a copy of each driver's history report for two years.

h. Policies regarding drug and alcohol use by our drivers:

- i. We follow FMCSA, PA Code, and Atlas Van lines policies and procedures. (1) No driver may report for duty or remain on duty requiring the performance of safety-sensitive functions while having an alcohol concentration of 0.04 or greater. (49 CFR §382.201) (2) No driver may engage in alcohol use while

performing safety-sensitive functions. (49 CFR §382.205) (3) No driver may perform safety-sensitive functions within four hours after having used alcohol. (49 CFR §382.207) (4) No driver required to take a post-accident alcohol test under this policy may use alcohol for eight hours following the accident, or until he/she undergoes a post-accident alcohol test, whichever occurs first. (49 CFR §382.209) (5) No driver may report for duty or remain on duty requiring the performance of safety-sensitive functions when the driver uses any controlled substance, except when the use is pursuant to the instructions of a licensed medical practitioner, as defined in 49 CFR § 382.107, who has advised the driver that the substance will not adversely affect the driver's ability to safely operate a motor vehicle. (49 CFR §382.213) (6) No driver may report for duty, remain on duty or perform a safety-sensitive function if the driver tests positive for a controlled substance. (49 CFR §382.215) (7) No driver may engage in conduct that involves a refusal to test involving any alcohol or controlled substance test required under this policy. (49 CFR §382.211) 3-3 A driver who violates these prohibitions will be immediately removed from service and disqualified from the performance of safety-sensitive functions and will be subject to disciplinary action by Atlas and Ace World Wide, up to and including discharge or loss of status as an Atlas-qualified driver. In addition, any driver who is convicted by the judicial system of a felony for a ~~drug or alcohol-related matter will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including discharge or~~ loss of status as an Atlas[1]qualified driver. 3-4 In the event Atlas has actual knowledge that a driver has violated any of the above prohibitions based on: 1) observation(s) of the driver; 2) information ~~provided by the driver's previous employer(s); 3) a traffic citation for driving a motor vehicle while~~ under the influence of alcohol or a controlled substance; or 4) a driver's admission of alcohol or controlled substance use, except as provided in 49 CFR §382.121, Atlas/Ace World Wide will prohibit him/her from performing any safety-sensitive functions.
