**TO ALL PARTIES OF RECORD**

Application of Gettysburg and Northern Railroad for approval to alter the public crossing (DOT 593 408 J) by the installation of upgraded railroad warning devices and replacement of the existing crossing surface where State Route 0234 (East York Street) crosses, at grade, the track of Gettysburg and Northern Railroad located in Biglerville Borough, Adams County.

To Whom It May Concern:

By Secretarial Letter dated December 4, 2023, Gettysburg and Northern Railroad was directed to complete the crossing alteration on or before December 31, 2024.

By letter-petition received by the Commission on December 6, 2024, Gettysburg and Northern Railroad requests an extension of time to complete the alteration of the crossing involved in the above captioned proceeding.

In its letter-petition Gettysburg and Northern Railroad stated that the project has taken longer to develop than originally anticipated. Gettysburg and Northern Railroad is therefore requesting an extension of time that establishes a completion date of December 31, 2025.

We have carefully reviewed the record in this proceeding and will grant Gettysburg and Northern Railroad an extension of time to December 31, 2025, to complete the alteration of the above captioned crossing.

This Commission issues this Secretarial Letter in accordance with Section 2702 of the Public Utility Code.

THEREFORE:

The letter-petition of Gettysburg and Northern Railroad received by the Commission on December 6, 2024, requesting an extension of time, be and is hereby granted to the extent herein directed:

1. Paragraph 11 of our Secretarial Letter dated December 4, 2023, which reads as follows, to wit:

“11. The alteration of the crossing be completed on or before December 31, 2024, and that on or before said date Gettysburg and Northern Railroad report in writing the date of actual completion of the work to this Commission and certify to the parties of record and this Commission that the work has been satisfactorily completed in accordance with the approved plans and this Secretarial Letter.”

be and is hereby modified to read:

11. The alteration of the crossing be completed on or before December 31, 2025, and that on or before said date Gettysburg and Northern Railroad report in writing the date of actual completion of the work to this Commission and certify to the parties of record and this Commission that the work has been satisfactorily completed in accordance with the approved plans and this Secretarial Letter.

2. In all respects not inconsistent herewith, our Secretarial Letter dated December 4, 2023, remains in full force and effect.

The Parties are reminded that failure to comply with this or any Order or Secretarial Letter in this proceeding may result in an enforcement action seeking civil penalties and/or other sanctions pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 3301.



If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to file by overnight delivery to ensure the timely filing of your submission. There are certain filings that cannot be eFiled, such as filings containing confidential or proprietary material. These must be submitted to the Secretary by overnight delivery, priority, or certified mail to allow tracking of your filing.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.31 and 5.44, file a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The Petition shall be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission or sent to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, and must be filed within twenty (20) days, or if no timely request is made, the action will be deemed to be a final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request; (2) the case docket number (it is provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter); (3) the party on whose behalf the petition is made; (4) a Certificate of Service on the other parties of record; and (5) a Verification with original signature in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36.
