On December 9, 2024, my office received the enclosed letter from the Complainant to the Initial Decision (ID) of Administrative Law Judge Christopher Pell issued on November 18, 2024, in the above captioned matter. The Complainant's letter is being considered as Exceptions filed to the ID and are considered timely filed. Exceptions were due by the close of business on December 9, 2024. However, there are deficiencies that must be corrected on the record.


First, this Secretarial Letter will also serve as an errata in correcting a typo on both the Initial Decision (ID) and accompanying Secretarial Letter serving the ID which both contain the docket number as F-2024-3038453. The correct docket number for this complaint is F-2024-3048453. This error has now been corrected on the record.

Second further review of the Complainant's Exceptions revealed that 1) the exceptions were improperly filed by faxing them to the Commission's Right to Know inbox; and 2) failure to serve the Exceptions on opposing counsel for PGW.

Faxed and emailed filings are not acceptable. However, the Complainant's Exceptions in this particular instance are being accepted. Complainant is directed in the future to file only by opening and using an efilings account or by mail. Additionally, no certificate of service or other indication that the parties of record to the case were served with the Complainant's Exceptions. Therefore, we have enclosed a copy of the Complainant's Exceptions to constitute service for purposes of 52 Pa. Code §5.533.

Due to the failure of the Complainant to provide service on all the parties of record to the case, and in order to avoid prejudice to any party pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.535, the Respondent shall have until the close of business on Friday, December 20, 2024, to file Reply Exceptions. No further filings will be accepted by either Party after that date.
