TARIFF FORMAT

A. Sheet Numbering - Sheet numbers appear in the upper right corner of the page. Sheets are numbered sequentially. However, new sheets are occasionally added to the tariff. When a new sheet is added between sheets already in effect, a decimal is added. For example, a new sheet added between sheets 14 and 15 would be 14.1.

B. Sheet Revision Numbers - Revision numbers also appear in the upper right corner of each page. These numbers are used to determine the most current sheet version on file with the Commission. For example, the 4th revised Sheet 14 cancels the third revised Sheet 14. PAPUC cancels the 3rd revised Sheet 14. Because of various suspension periods, deferrals, etc. the Commission follows in their tariff approval process, the most current sheet number on file with the Commission is not always the tariff page in effect. Consult the Check Sheet for the sheet currently in effect.

C. Paragraph Numbering Sequence - There are nine levels of paragraph coding. Each level of coding is subservient to its next higher level:

D. Check Sheets - When a tariff filing is made with the Commission, an updated check sheet accompanies the tariff filing. All revisions made in a given filing are designated by an asterisk (*). There will be no other symbols used on this page if these are the only changes made to it (i.e., the format, etc. remains the same, just revised revision levels on some pages). The tariff user should refer to the latest check sheet to find out if a particular sheet is the most current on file with the PAPUC.

APPLICATION OF TARIFF

The regulations and schedules of charges in this tariff govern the furnishing of local telephone service and facilities by Stratus Network, Inc., hereafter referred to as the Company within the service areas of Verizon Pennsylvania LLC, Verizon North LLC, Brightspeed of Pennsylvania, LLC, Consolidated Communications of Pennsylvania Company, Commonwealth Telephone Company d/b/a Frontier Communications, Commonwealth Telephone Company and Windstream Pennsylvania LLC.as identified in their respective tariffs.

This tariff is in concurrence with all applicable State and Federal Laws (including, but not limited to, 52 Pa. Code, 66 Pa. C.S., and the Communications Act of 1934, as amended), and with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's applicable Rules and Regulations and Orders. Any provisions contained in this Tariff that are inconsistent with the foregoing mentioned will be deemed inoperative and superseded.

This tariff supplements and governs all other applicable tariffs of the Company and also any tariffs or portions of tariffs of other companies with which this Company concurs.

DEFINITIONS

Certain terms used generally throughout this tariff are defined below.

Access Line: A circuit between the station protector on the Customer's telephone service or PBX to, and including, the serving central office main frame.

Advance Payment: Part or all of a payment required before the start of service.

Authorized User: A person, firm corporation, or any other entity authorized by the Customer to communicate utilizing the Company's service.

Business or Commercial Customer: In general, Business Customers are those who have access lines that terminate at offices, mills, stores or a business location. Business rates apply if the service is used primarily or substantially for business purposes even if the access line does not terminate at a business location, or if the access line has a business directory listing.

Call: A completed connection established between a calling station and one or more called stations.

Collect Billing: A billing arrangement whereby the originating caller may bill the charges for a call to the called party, provided the called party agrees to accept the charges.

Commission: The Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission.

Company: Stratus Networks, Inc., the issuer of this tariff.

Customer or Subscriber: The person, firm or corporation that orders service and is responsible for the payment of charges and compliance with the Company's regulations.

Direct Inward Dial (or "DID"): A service attribute that routes incoming calls directly to stations, by-passing a central answering point.

Host Telephone Company: The service provider, which is also the telecommunications public utility that provides 9-1-1 service to the county/municipality, and that houses the Automatic Location Identification (ALI)/MSAG data used for providing 9-1-1 service.

Hunting: Routes a call to an idle station line in a prearranged group when the called station line is busy.

ILEC: Incumbent Local Exchange Company.

Joint User: A person, firm or corporation that is designated by the Customer as a user of services furnished to the Customer by Company and to whom a portion of the charges for the service will be billed under a joint user arrangement as specified herein

LATA: A Local Access and Transport Area established pursuant to the Modification of Final Judgment entered by the United States District Court for the District of Columbia in Civil Action No. 82-0192; or any other geographic area designated as a LATA in the National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc. Tariff F.C.C. No. 4.

Local Exchange Carrier or (LEC): Denotes any individual, partnership, association, joint-stock company, trust or corporation engaged in providing switched communication within an exchange.

MSAG Content: The data elements of the MSAG (Master Street Address Guide) including (but not necessarily limited to) the data elements that are entered into the following fields A-I of a standard MSAG record:

- A. Tax area record
- B. Locality
- C. Street
- D. Thoroughfare
- E. Directional [where required]
- F. Even (E), odd (O), or all (A) [applied to house numbers]
- G. Low-high range of house numbers
- H. PSAP (Public Safety Answering Point)
- I. LAT/LONG (Latitude/Longitude) [where required]

MSAG Formatting, Format: Shall include changes to the identity of fields, order of fields, and number and arrangement of data elements in each field, and a telephone company's rearrangement or regrouping of such data, without changing the MSAG content, for purposes of validating against MSAG records. Nonrecurring Charges or NRCs: One-time charges most often associated with installation, ordering, or account establishment.

Station-to-Station Call: A service whereby an End User places a non-Person-to-Person call with the assistance of an operator.

Person-to-Person Call: A service whereby the person originating the call specifies a particular person to be reached, or a particular station, room number, department, or office to be reached through a PBX attendant.

Recurring Charges (MRCs): The monthly charges to the Customer for services, facilities and equipment, that continue for the agreed upon duration of the service.

Service Commencement Date: The first day following the date on which the Company notifies the Customer that the requested service or facility is available for use, unless extended by the Customer's refusal to accept service that does not conform to standards set forth in the Service Order or this tariff, in which case the Service Commencement Date is the date of the Customer's acceptance. The Company and Customer may mutually agree on a substitute Service Commencement Date.

Service Order: The written request for Services executed by the Customer and the Company in the format devised by the Company. The signing of a Service Order by the Customer and acceptance by the Company initiates the respective obligations of the parties as set forth therein and pursuant to this tariff, but the duration of the service is calculated from the Service Commencement Date.

Shared: A facility or equipment system or subsystem that can be used simultaneously by several Customers.

Telephone Company: A telecommunications public utility regulated by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission and which has or requests access to the county/municipality 9-1-1 system or connection to the serving selective router, including, but not limited to, local exchange carriers and competitive local exchange carriers. This term is synonymous with 'service provider'.

Telephone Company system: Reference to a service provider's own facilities-based network or, if operating as a nonfacilities-based competitive local exchange carrier, the facilities contracted by the Telephone Company for provision of service.

Two Way: A service attribute that includes outward dial capabilities for outbound calls and can also be used to carry inbound calls to a central point for further processing.

User or End User: A Customer, Joint User, or any other person authorized by a Customer to use service provided under this tariff.

2.1 Undertaking of the Company

2.1.1 Scope

The Company undertakes to furnish communications service pursuant to the terms of this tariff in connection with one-way and/or two-way information transmission between points within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Customers and users may use services and facilities provided under this tariff to obtain access to services offered by other service providers. The Company is responsible under this tariff only for the services and facilities described herein, and it assumes no responsibility for any service provided by any other entity that purchases access to the Company network in order to originate or terminate its own services, or to communicate with its own customers.

2.1.2 Shortage of Equipment or Facilities

A. The Company reserves the right to limit or to allocate the use of existing facilities, or of additional facilities offered by the Company, when necessary because of lack of facilities, or due to any other cause beyond the Company's control.

B. The furnishing of service under this tariff is subject to the availability on a continuing basis of all the necessary facilities and is limited to the capacity of the Company's facilities as well as facilities the Company may obtain from other carriers to furnish service from time to time as required at the sole discretion of the Company.

2.1 Undertaking of the Company (Cont'd)

2.1.3 Terms and Conditions

- A. Service is provided on the basis of a minimum period of at least one (1) month. If a Customer must pay the regular tariffed rate for the service they subscriber to for the minimum period of service. If a Customer disconnects service before the end of the minimum service period, that customer is responsible for paying the regular rates for the remainder of the minimum service period. When the service is moved within the same building, to another building on the same premises, or to a different premises entirely, the period of service at each location is accumulated to calculate if the Customer has met the minimum period of service obligations.

If service is terminated before the end of the minimum period of service as a result of condemnation of property, damage to property requiring the premises to be abandoned, or by the death of the Customer, the Customer is not obligated to pay for service for the remainder of the minimum period.

If service is switched over to a new Customer at the same premises after the first month's service, the minimum period of service requirements are assigned to the new Customer if the new Customer agrees in writing to accept them. The new Customer will be billed only for services rendered and any bill will be pro-rated to reflect only charges for services rendered.

- B. Customers may be required to enter into written Service Orders which shall contain or reference a specific description of the service ordered, the rates to be charged, the duration of the services, and the terms and conditions in this tariff. Customers will also be required to execute any other documents as may be reasonably requested by the Company.
- C. Service may be terminated upon written notice to the Customer if:
1. the Customer is using the service in violation of this tariff; or
 2. the Customer is using the service in violation of the law.

2.1 Undertaking of the Company (Cont'd)

2.1.4 Liability of the Company

- A. The liability of the Company for damages arising out of the furnishing of its Services, including but not limited to mistakes, omissions, interruptions, delays, or errors, or other defects, representations, or use of these services or arising out of the failure to furnish the service, whether caused by acts or omission, shall be limited to the extension of allowances for interruption as set forth in Section 2.6 of this tariff. The extension of such allowances for interruption shall be the sole remedy of the Customer and the sole liability of the Company. The Company will not be liable for any direct, indirect, incidental, special, consequential, exemplary or punitive damages to Customer as a result of any Company service, equipment or facilities.

- B. The Company shall not be liable for any delay or failure of performance or equipment due to causes beyond its control, including but not limited to: acts of God, fire, flood, explosion or other catastrophes; any law, order, regulation, direction, action, or request of the United States Government, or of any other government, including state and local governments having or claiming jurisdiction over the Company, or of any department, agency, commission, bureau, corporation, or other instrumentality of any one or more of these federal, state, or local governments, or of any civil or military authority; national emergencies; insurrections; riots; wars; unavailability of rights-of-way or materials; or strikes, lock-outs, work stoppages, or other labor difficulties

2.1.4 Liability of the Company (Cont'd)

- C. The Company shall not be liable for any act or omission of any entity furnishing to the Company or to the Company's Customers facilities or equipment used for or with the services the Company offers.
- D. The Company shall not be liable for any damages or losses due to the fault or negligence of the Customer or due to the failure or malfunction of Customer- provided equipment or facilities.
- E. The Company does not guarantee nor make any warranty with respect to installations it provides for use in a hazardous environment. The Customer indemnifies and holds the Company harmless from any and all loss, claims, demands, suits, or other action, or any liability whatsoever, whether suffered, made, instituted, or asserted by any other party or person(s), and for any loss, damage, or destruction of any property, whether owned by the Customer or others, caused or claimed to have been caused directly or indirectly by the installation, operation, failure to operate, maintenance, condition, location, or use of any installation so provided. The Company reserves the right to require each Customer to sign an agreement acknowledging acceptance of the provisions of this Section 2.1.4.E as a condition precedent to such installations.
- F. The Company is not liable for any defacement of or damage to Customer premises resulting from the furnishing of services or equipment on such premises or the installation or removal thereof, unless such defacement or damage is caused by negligence or willful misconduct of the Company's agents or employees.
- G. The Customer and any authorized or joint users, jointly and severally shall indemnify, defend and hold the company harmless against claims, loss, damages, expenses for libel, slander, or infringement of copyright arising from the material transmitted over the lines of its underlying carrier; against claims for infringement of patents arising from combining with, or use in connection with, equipment and systems of the Customer; and against all other claims arising out of any act or omission of the customer in connection with services provided by the Company or equipment provided by the Customer.

2.1.4 Liability of the Company (Cont'd)

In the event any such infringing use is enjoined, the Customer, authorized user or joint user at its option and expense, shall obtain immediately a dismissal or stay of such injunction, obtain a license or other agreement so as to extinguish any claim of infringement, or terminate the claimed infringing use or modify such infringement.

H. Customer-Provided Equipment

The services furnished by the Company are subject to the following limitations: The Company shall not be liable for damages arising out of mistakes, omissions, interruptions, delay, errors or defects in transmission or other injury, including but not limited to injuries to persons or property from voltages or currents transmitted over the facilities of the underlying carrier of the Company caused by customer-provided equipment or premises wire.

- I. The entire liability for any claim, loss, damage or expense from any cause whatsoever shall in no event exceed sums actually paid to the Company by the Customer for the specific services giving rise to the claim. No action or proceeding against the Company shall be commenced more than one year after the service is rendered.

2.1.4 Liability of the Company (Cont'd)

J. The Company makes no warranties or representations, express or implied either in fact or by operation of law, statutory or otherwise, including warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular use, except those expressly set forth herein

K. Directory Errors - Company liability, if any, for its gross negligence or willful misconduct is not limited by this tariff. With respect to any other claim or suit, by a Customer or any others, for damages arising from errors or omissions in the making up or printing of its directories or in accepting listings as presented by customers or prospective customers, the Company liability, if any, shall not exceed the amount paid for local exchange service during the period covered by the directory in which the error or omission occurred.

- i. Free Listings: For free or no-charge published director listings, credit shall be limited to an amount not to exceed one-half the amount of the exchange service charges for mail telephone exchange lines, PBX trunks, and Centrex main station lines during the period covered by the primary directory.
- ii. Charge Listing: For additional or charge published directory listings, the company is limited to an amount not exceeding the amount of charges for the charged listing or listings involved, during the period covered by the directory in which the error or omission occurs.
- iii. Credit Limitation: The total amount of the credit provided for in Section 2.1.4.K.i and 2.1.4.K.ii above shall not exceed, on a monthly basis, the total of the charges for each charge listing plus the basic monthly rate for the line or lines in question.

2.1.4 Liability of the Company (Cont'd)

- iv. Definitions: As used in Section 2.1.4.K.i and 2.1.4.K.ii above, the term "error," "mistake," or "omission" shall refer to a discrepancy in the directory listing or directory assistance records which the Company has failed to correct and where the error affects the ability to locate a particular Customer's correct telephone number. These terms shall refer to addresses only to the extent that an error, mistake, or omission of an address places the Customer on an incorrect street or in an incorrect community.
- v. Notice: Such allowance or credits as specified in this Section 2.1.4 shall be given upon notice to the Company by the Customer that such error, mistake or omission has occurred; provided, however, that when it is administratively feasible for the Company to have knowledge of such error, mistake or omission, the Company shall give credit without the requirement of notification by a Customer.

2.1.5 Notification of Service-Affecting Activities

The Company will provide the Customer reasonable notification of service-affecting activities that may occur in normal operation of its business. Such activities may include, but are not limited to, equipment or facilities additions, removals or rearrangements and routine preventative maintenance. Generally, such activities are not specific to an individual Customer but affect many Customers' services. No specific advance notification period is applicable to all service activities. The Company will work cooperatively with the Customer to determine the reasonable notification requirements. With some emergency or unplanned service-affecting conditions, such as an outage resulting from cable damage, notification to the Customer may not be possible

2.2 Universal Emergency Telephone Number Service (911, E911)

2.2.1 General

2.2.1.1 Enhanced Emergency Number Service (E911) allows the Customer to reach appropriate emergency services including police, fire and medical services. Enhanced 911 has the ability to selectively route an emergency call to the primary 911 provider so that it reaches the correct emergency service located closest to the caller. Host Telephone Company: The service provider, which is also the telecommunications public utility that provides 911 service to the county/municipality, and that houses the Automatic Location Identification (ALI)/Master Street Address Guide (MSAG) data used for providing 911 service.

Content: The data elements of the MSAG including but not necessarily limited to the data elements that are entered into the following fields A-I of a standard MSAG record:

- A. Tax area record
- B. Locality
- C. Street
- D. Thoroughfare
- E. Directional [where required]
- F. Even (E), odd (O), or all (A) [applied to house numbers]
- G. Low-high range of house numbers
- H. PSAP (Public Safety Answering Point)
- I. LAT/LONG (Latitude/Longitude) [where required]

Formatting, Format: Shall include changes to the identity of fields, order of fields, and number and arrangement of data elements in each field, and a telephone company's rearrangement or regrouping of such data, without changing the MSAG content, for purposes of validating against MSAG records.

Service Provider: A telecommunications public utility regulated by the Commission and which has or requests access to the county/municipality 911 system or connection to the serving selective router, including but not limited to local exchange carriers and competitive local exchange carriers.

2.2.2 Terms (Cont'd)

Telephone Company System: Reference to a service provider's own facilities-based network or, if operating as a nonfacilities-based competitive local exchange carrier, the facilities contracted by the telephone company for provision of service.

2.2.3 Regulations

The Company, whether supplying service through its own facilities or the use of an underlying carrier, will comply with the Protocols as set forth in, and in the form of Service Provider E-9-1-1 Protocols, Service Provider E-9-1-1 Questionnaire and Testing Procedures in accordance with the Petition of Bell Atlantic-Pennsylvania, Inc. for a Declaratory Order Relating to the Provision of Master Street Address Guides; Docket No. P-00971203; Settlement Agreement of all Parties and Joint Petition entered August 7, 1998.

The Company is indemnified under the Public Safety Emergency Telephone Act, Act 78 of 1990.

The Company's liability is fully stated in Sections 2.2.1.2 and 2.2.1.3 of this tariff and in Section 2 of this Tariff.

Cases of service interruptions affecting public health and safety shall receive priority attention under any and all conditions, particularly in time of disaster. Every appropriate resource will be utilized. The service provider will make reasonable best efforts to have its system fully functional as soon as possible, unless conditions beyond the service provider's control prevent service restoration.

The Host Telephone Company will install the county's/municipality's MSAG in "read/write" format and will not modify the content of the MSAG unless requested or permitted to do so by the county/municipality. A request to modify content by the Host Telephone Company shall be responded to by the county/municipality within ten (10) business days or the request is deemed to be approved. The request shall be in writing and shall set forth in reasonable detail the proposed modification and all reasons in support. The request shall be granted provided the modification is necessary for the Host Telephone Company's provision, maintenance, or upgrading of the 911 service.

2.2.5 Special Construction

Subject to the agreement of the Company and to all of the regulations contained in this tariff, special construction of facilities may be undertaken on a reasonable efforts basis at the request of the Customer. Charges for special construction will be developed on an individual case basis (ICB). ICB contracts will be filed with the Commission upon request. Special construction is that construction undertaken:

- A. where facilities are not presently available, and there is no other requirement for the facilities so constructed;

2.3 Pennsylvania Telecommunications Relay Service

2.3.1 General

The Pennsylvania Telecommunications Relay Service (PA TRS) is a relay telecommunication service for the deaf, hard of hearing, hearing and/or speech disabled population of the Commonwealth. The PA TRS is mandated by the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 to provide functionally equivalent telephone services that are available to other U.S. citizens, at no additional cost. The PA TRS includes both traditional relay (devices such as Teletypewriters (TTY) and Telecommunication Devices for the Deaf (TDD)) and captioned- telephone voice-carry-over relay services (captioned telephone). These relay services permit telephone communications between individuals with hearing and/or speech disabilities, who must use a TTY, TDD or captioned telephone, with individuals having normal hearing and speech. Additionally, 711 abbreviated dialing is available to access the PA TRS. The Company's switching equipment is arranged to translate the "711" calls to the assigned toll-free number, (888) 895-1197, in order to route calls to the TRS Provider, in accordance with Commission's Order entered on February 4, 2000 in Docket No. M-00900239.

2.3.2 Surcharge

In addition to the charges provided in this Tariff, a surcharge will apply to all business access lines served by the Company. This surcharge applies regardless of whether or not the access line uses the PA TRS.

The surcharge serves as the funding vehicle for the operation of the PA TRS, Telecommunications Device Distribution Program and the Print Media Access Service Program and shall be calculated by the Commission. The Commission shall compute the PA TRS surcharge each year and notify local exchange carriers of the surcharge amount to be applied for the twelve-month period commencing with July 1 of each year. The Commission may revise the surcharge more frequently than annually at its discretion. Tariff revisions will be filed whenever

2.4 Obligations of the Customer

2.4.1 General

The Customer shall be responsible for:

- A. the payment of all applicable charges pursuant to this tariff;
- B. damage to or loss of the Company's facilities or equipment caused by the acts or omissions of the Customer, or the noncompliance by the Customer, with these regulations, or by fire or theft or other casualty on the Customer Premises, unless caused by the gross negligence or intentional misconduct of the employees or agents of the Company;

Any and all costs associated with obtaining and maintaining the rights-of-way described herein, including the costs of altering the structure to permit installation of the Company-provided facilities, shall be borne entirely by, or may be charged by the Company to, the Customer. The Company may require the Customer to demonstrate its compliance with this section prior to accepting an order for service;
- E. providing a safe place to work and complying with all laws and regulations regarding the working conditions on the premises at which Company employees and agents shall be installing or maintaining the Company's facilities and equipment. The Customer may be required to install and maintain Company facilities and equipment within a hazardous area if, in the Company's opinion, injury or damage to the Company's employees or property might result from installation or maintenance by the Company. The Customer shall be responsible for identifying, monitoring, removing and disposing of any hazardous material prior to any construction or installation work;

- F. complying with all laws and regulations applicable to, and obtaining all consents, approvals, licenses and permits as may be required with respect to, the location of Company facilities and equipment in any Customer premises or the rights-of-way for which Customer is responsible under Section 2.4.1.D; and granting or obtaining permission for Company agents or employees to enter the premises of the Customer at any time for the purpose of installing, inspecting, maintaining, repairing, or upon termination of service as stated herein, removing the facilities or equipment of the Company;
- G. not creating, or allowing to be placed, any liens or other encumbrances on the Company's equipment or facilities; and

No allowance will be made for the period during which service is interrupted for such purposes.

2.3.2 Claims

With respect to any service or facility provided by the Company, Customers shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Company from and against all claims, actions, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses for:

- A. any loss, destruction or damage to the property of the Company or any third party, or death or injury to persons, including, but not limited to, employees or invitees of either party, to the extent caused by or resulting from the negligent or intentional act or omission of the Customer, its employees, agents, representatives or invitees; or

2.5 Customer Equipment and Channels

2.5.1 General

A User may transmit or receive information or signals via the facilities of the Company. The Company's services are designed primarily for the transmission of voice-grade telephonic signals, except as otherwise stated in this tariff. A User may transmit any form of signal that is compatible with the Company's equipment, but the Company does not represent that its services will be suitable for purposes other than voice-grade telephonic communication except as specifically stated in this tariff.

2.5.2 Station Equipment

- A. Terminal equipment on the User's premises and the electric power consumed by such equipment shall be provided by and maintained at the expense of the User. The User is responsible for the provision of wiring or cable to connect its terminal equipment to the Company point of connection.
- B. The Customer is responsible for ensuring that Customer-provided equipment connected to Company equipment and facilities is compatible with such equipment and facilities. The magnitude and character of the voltages and currents impressed on Company-provided equipment and wiring by the connection, operation, or maintenance of such equipment and wiring shall be such as not to cause damage to the Company-provided equipment and wiring or injury to the Company's employees or to other persons. Any additional protective equipment required to prevent such damage or injury shall be provided by the Company at the Customer's expense.

2.5.3 Interconnection of Facilities

- A. Any special interface equipment necessary to achieve compatibility between the facilities and equipment of the Company used for furnishing Communication Services and the channels, facilities, or equipment of others shall be provided at the Customer's expense.
- B. Communication services may be connected to the services or facilities of other communications carriers only when authorized by, and in accordance with, the terms and conditions of the tariffs of the other communications carriers that are applicable to such connections.
- C. Facilities furnished under this tariff may be connected to Customer-provided terminal equipment in accordance with the provisions of this tariff. All such terminal equipment shall be registered by the Federal Communications Commission, and all User-provided wiring shall be installed and maintained in compliance with applicable regulations.

2.5.4 Inspections

- A. Upon suitable notification to the Customer, and at a reasonable time, the Company may make such tests and inspections as may be necessary to determine that the Customer is complying with the requirements set forth herein for the installation, operation, and maintenance of Customer-provided facilities, equipment, and wiring in the connection of Customer-provided facilities and equipment to Company- owned facilities and equipment.
- B. If the protective requirements for Customer-provided equipment are not being complied with, the Company may take such action as it deems necessary to protect its facilities, equipment, and personnel. The Company will notify the Customer promptly if there is any need for further corrective action. Within ten days of receiving this notice, the Customer must take corrective action and notify the Company of the action taken. If the Customer fails to do this, the Company may take whatever additional action is deemed necessary, including the suspension of service, to protect its facilities, equipment and personnel from harm.

2.6 Payment Arrangements

2.6.1 Payment for Services

The Customer is responsible for the payment of all charges for facilities and services furnished by the Company to the Customer and to all Users authorized by the Customer, regardless of whether those services are used by the Customer itself or are resold to or shared with other persons.

E911 -- Pursuant to applicable Pennsylvania rules and regulations, the Company shall mandate a monthly surcharge to be levied upon each business telephone line or trunk in the state including PBX trunks and Centrex equivalent trunks and each line or trunk serving and upon each user interface number or extension number or similarly identifiable line, trunk, or path to or from a digital network (such as, but not exclusive of, integrated services digital network (ISDN), Flexpath or comparable digital PBX, or connecting to or from a customer-based or dedicated telephone switch site (such as but not exclusive of, a PBX), or connecting to or from a Customer-based or dedicated central office.

Sales and Use Tax -- All state and local taxes (i.e., sales tax) are listed as separate line items and are not included in the rates quoted in the Rate Schedules.

2.6.2 Billing and Collection of Charges

Charges for service, other than usage charges, are due monthly in advance. All other charges are payable upon request of the Company. Bills are due on the due date shown on the bill and are payable at any business office of the Company, by U.S. Mail, or at any location designated by the Company. If the Company does not receive objection within three (3) months after the bill is rendered, the items and charges appearing thereon shall be determined to be correct and binding upon the Customer. A bill will not be deemed correct and binding upon the Customer if the Company has records on the basis of which an objection may be considered, or if the Customer has in their possession such Company records. If objection results in a refund to the Customer, such refund will be with interest at the greater of the unadjusted customer deposit rate or the applicable late payment rate, if any, for the service classification under which the Customer was billed. Interest will be paid from the date when the Customer overpayment was made, adjusted for any changes in the deposit rate or late payment rate, compounded monthly.

2.6.3 Billing and Collection of Charges (Cont'd)

- A. Billing of the Customer by the Company will begin on the Service Commencement Date, which is the first day following the date on which the Company notifies the Customer that the service or facility is available for use, except that the Service Commencement Date may be postponed by mutual agreement of the parties, or if the service or facility does not conform to standards set forth in this tariff or the Service Order. Billing accrues through and includes the day that the service, circuit, arrangement or component is discontinued.

2.6.4 Late Payment Charges

- A. Customer bills for telephone service are due on the due date specified on the bill. If a bill is paid by mail, the date of the postmark shall be considered the date of payment. A Customer is in default unless payment is made on or before the due date specified on the bill. If payment is not received by a Customer's next billing date, a late payment charge of 1.25% will be applied to all amounts previously billed under this Tariff, excluding one (1) month's local service charge.
- B. For Business Customers, all amounts outstanding twenty-five (25) days or more from the date on which the bill for such amounts is mailed are subject to a late payment charge. If a bill is paid by mail, the date of the postmark shall be considered the date of payment. The late payment charge will be calculated at an annual rate of interest, which is equivalent of the rate paid on two-year United States Treasury notes for the preceding twelve (12) months ending December 31st of any year, plus ten percent (10%).
- C. Late payment charges do not apply to those portions (and only those portions) of unpaid balances that are associated with disputed amounts. Undisputed amounts on the same bill as disputed amounts are subject to late payment charges if unpaid and carried forward to the next bill.
- D. Late payment charges do not apply to final accounts.

2.6.4 Late Payment Charges

- E. Late payment charges do not apply to all agencies of the Commonwealth, including constitutional offices, the legislature, and the judiciary. Cities, towns, municipalities, counties, and other political subdivisions of the Commonwealth, including schools and other service districts also are exempt. Authorities, commissions, and institutions of higher learning of the Commonwealth, as well as quasi-public agencies for the benefit of the citizens of the Commonwealth, also are exempt.
- F. If service is disconnected by the Company in accordance with Section 2.6.3 and later reinstalled, service will be subject to all applicable installation charges. If service is suspended by the Company and later restored, service will be subject to all applicable restoration charges.

2.6.5 Returned Check Charge

When a check which has been presented to the Company by a Customer in payment for charges is returned by the bank, the Customer shall be responsible for the payment of a Returned Check Charge of \$40.00.

2.6.6 Advance Payments

For Customers whom the Company determines an advance payment is necessary, that advanced payment may be required for construction of facilities, furnishing special equipment, or temporary service for short term use. The Company reserves the right to collect an amount not to exceed two (2) months estimated charges as an advance payment for service. This will be applied against the next month's charges and a new advance payment may be collected for the next month, if necessary.

2.6.7 Deposits

A. General

Except as provided in Section 2.6.7.B below, the Company may require a deposit from a Customer who is applying for service: (1) if the Customer's financial condition is unknown or unacceptable to the Company, (2) if the Customer has had service terminated for nonpayment once within the preceding six-month period, or (3) if the Customer is delinquent in payment of \$25.00 or more. A Customer is also considered delinquent in payment if their account for telephone service remains unpaid for at least thirty (30) days after receipt of a bill prepared and delivered in accordance with this Tariff. A Customer is not considered delinquent if an amount in dispute is not paid before the dispute is resolved.

A new Customer is an applicant for service who has not been a Customer of the Company within twelve (12) months of making the request for service. A new Customer shall not be required to post a security deposit as a condition of receiving telephone service.

An existing Customer is an applicant for service who was a Customer of the Company within twelve (12) months of making the request, provided that prior service was not terminated for nonpayment, unless service is requested within ten (10) days of such termination for nonpayment. Applicants for service and existing Customers are permitted to pay deposits in installments over a period not to exceed six (6) months.

A seasonal Customer is an individual who applies for and receives telephone service periodically each year, intermittently during the year, or at other regular intervals scheduled at the time of application. A seasonal Customer may be required to post a deposit.

2.6.7 Deposits (Cont'd)

At the time of making a deposit, each Customer shall receive a written receipt containing at least the following information: name of Customer, place of payment, date of payment, amount of payment, identifiable name and signature of the Company employee receiving the payment, and statement of the terms and conditions governing the receipt, retention and return of deposit funds. A Customer's failure to produce a receipt shall not deprive that Customer of the right to the refund to which the Customer is otherwise entitled.

B. Customer Exempt from Deposits

The Company shall not require any person it knows to be a recipient of public assistance, supplemental security income, or additional state payments to post a deposit.

C. Recent Payment History

A Customer who has a recent payment history (within the preceding twelve (12) months) with the Company is entitled to service without payment of a deposit unless their records indicate a delinquency in payment or a termination of service for nonpayment. A Customer who still owes money to the Company for service on a prior account shall be offered a deferred payment plan, provided that the Customer had service for three (3) months and was not terminated for nonpayment during that period.

New deposits from a Customer are reviewed after the first six (6) months of service and each additional month thereafter. Any excess deposit will be returned. The Company may request an additional amount in the event of any deposit shortfall. The entire deposit will be returned to a Customer after one (1) year, unless the Customer is delinquent in payment, in which case the Company may continue to retain the deposit until the delinquency is satisfied. If the service is discontinued, the deposit is applied against the final bill, and any balance is returned to the Customer.

2.6.7 Deposits (Cont'd)

D. Interest on Deposits

The amount of the deposit shall be sufficient to provide security to cover two- twelfths (2/12s) of the estimated charges for the ensuing twelve (12) months. Estimated charges for services in determining deposits shall not include the estimate of charges of any interexchange carrier or any entity other than the Company. Interest at the rate of six percent (6%) annually shall be payable on all deposits without deduction for any taxes on such deposits. Interest shall be credited annually to the Customer's account or paid with the return of the deposit, whichever occurs first.

E. Inadequate Deposits

If the amount of a deposit is proven to be less than required to meet the requirements specified above, the Customer shall be required to pay an additional deposit upon request.

F. Return of Deposits

When a deposit is to be returned, the Customer may request that the full amount of the deposit be issued by check. If the Customer requests that the full amount be credited to amounts owed the Company, the Company will process the transaction on the billing date and apply the deposit to any amount currently owed to the Company, and return any remaining amount of the deposit to the Customer by check.

2.6.8 Suspension and Termination of Service

1. Upon nonpayment of any amounts owing to the Company, the Company may suspend service by giving ten (10) days prior written notice to the Customer. In the event payment is not received within ten (10) days of the suspension of service, the Company may terminate service without incurring any liability.

2.6.8 Suspension and Termination of Service (Cont'd)

2. Upon violation of any of the other material term or condition for furnishing service the Company may, by giving ten (10) days prior notice in writing to the Customer, discontinue or suspend service without incurring any liability if such violation continues during that period.
3. Upon condemnation of any material portion of the facilities used by the Company to provide service to a Customer or if a casualty renders all or any material portion of such facilities inoperable beyond feasible repair, the Company, by notice to the Customer, may discontinue or suspend service without incurring any liability.
4. Upon a Customer's insolvency, assignment for the benefit of creditors, filing for bankruptcy or reorganization, or failing to discharge an involuntary petition within the time permitted by law, the Company may immediately discontinue or suspend service without incurring any liability and shall provide notice to the Customer.
5. Upon any governmental prohibition or required alteration of the services to be provided or any violation of an applicable law or regulation, the Company may immediately discontinue service without incurring any liability and shall provide notice to a Customer as set forth by applicable regulations.
6. In the event of fraudulent use of the Company's network, the Company will discontinue service without notice this provision.
7. Upon the Company's discontinuance of service to a Customer under Section 2.6.1 or 2.6.2, the Company, in addition to all other remedies that may be available to the Company at law or in equity or under any other provision of this Tariff, may declare all future monthly and other charges that would have been payable by the Customer during the remainder of the term for which such services otherwise would have been provided to the Customer, to be immediately due and payable.

2.6.9 Cancellation of Application for Service

Applications for service cannot be canceled without the Company's agreement. Where the Company permits a Customer to cancel an application for service prior to the start of service or prior to any special construction, charges will be imposed as described herein.

- A. Where, prior to cancellation by the Customer, the Company incurs any expenses in installing the service or in preparing to install the service that it otherwise would not have incurred, a charge equal to the costs incurred by the Company, less net salvage, shall apply, but in no case shall this charge exceed the sum of the charge as specified in Section 4 for the minimum period of services ordered, including installation charges, and all charges others levied against the Company that would have been chargeable to the Customer had service commenced.
8. In addition to those charges specified in Section 4, where the Company incurs any expense in connection with special construction, or where special arrangements of facilities or equipment have begun, before the Company receives a cancellation notice, a charge equal to the costs incurred by the Company, less net salvage, applies. In such cases, the charge will be based on such elements as the cost of the equipment, facilities, and material, the cost of installation, engineering, labor, and supervision, general and administrative expense, other disbursements, depreciation, maintenance, taxes, provision for return on investment, and any other costs associated with the special construction or arrangements.
9. The special charges described herein will be calculated and applied on a case-by-case basis.

2.6.10 Changes in Service Requested

Trouble Isolation Charge: When a visit to the Customer's premises is necessary to isolate a problem reported to the Company but identified by the Company's technician as attributable to customer-provided equipment or inside wire, a separate charge applies in addition to all other charges for the visit.

2.6.11 Duplicate Invoice Charges

A Duplicate Invoice Charge of \$25.00 will be applied on a per invoice basis to a Customer who requests a copy of a bill that has already been issued to such Customer, unless the Customer informs the Company, within 15 days of the issuance of the bill, that the original bill was not received. If a Customer or the Customer's representative, thereafter, requests additional copies of bills, a charge will apply for each requested bill.

2.7 Adjustments and Allowances for Interruptions

Interruptions in service will be credited to the Customer as set forth in this Tariff. A credit allowance will be made when an interruption occurs because of a failure of any component furnished by the Company under this Tariff.

2.7.1 Limitation on Allowances

No credit allowance will be made for interruptions due to the failure or malfunction of non-Company equipment or services, including service connected to Customer-provided electric power

2.7.1 Limitation on Allowances (Cont'd)

- A. Interruptions of service during any period in which the Company is not given full and free access to its facilities and equipment for the purpose of investigating and correcting interruptions;
- B. Interruptions of service during any period in which the Customer continues to use the service on an impaired basis;
- C. Interruptions of service during any period when the Customer has released service to the Company for maintenance purposes or for implementation of a Customer order for a change in service arrangements; and
- D. Interruption of service due to circumstances or causes beyond the control of the Company. 2.8 Cancellation of Service

If a Customer terminates services before the completion of the term commitment for any reason whatsoever other than a service interruption (as defined in Section 2.7 above), the Customer agrees to pay to the Company termination liability charges, as defined below. These charges shall become due as of the effective date of the cancellation or termination and be payable within the period, set forth in Section 2.6.

Customer's termination liability for cancellation of service shall be equal to:

2.8.1 all unpaid Non-Recurring charges reasonably expended by Company to establish service to Customer; plus

2.8.2 any disconnection, early cancellation or termination charges reasonably incurred and paid to third parties by Company on behalf of Customer; plus

2.8.3 all Recurring Charges specified in the applicable Service Order for the balance of the then-current term commitment.

2.9 Transfers and Assignments

Neither the Company nor the Customer may assign or transfer its rights or duties in connection with the services and facilities provided by the Company without the written consent of the other party, except that the Company may assign its rights and duties:

2.9.1 to any subsidiary, parent company or affiliate of the Company; or

2.9.2 pursuant to any sale or transfer of substantially all the assets of the Company; or

2.9.3 pursuant to any financing, merger or reorganization of the Company.

- 2.10.1 The Customer shall designate on the Service Order an address to which the Company shall mail or deliver all notices and other communications, except that the Customer may also designate a separate address to which the Company's bills for service shall be mailed.
- 2.10.2 The Company shall designate on the Service Order an address to which the Customer shall mail or deliver all notices and other communications, except that Company may designate a separate address on each bill for service to which the Customer shall mail payment on that bill.
- 2.10.3 All notices or other communications required to be given pursuant to this tariff will be in writing. Notices and other communications of either party, and all bills mailed by the Company, shall be presumed to have been delivered to the other party on the third business day following placement of the notice, communication or bill with the U.S. Mail or a private delivery service, prepaid and properly addressed, or when actually received or refused by the addressee, whichever occurs first.
- 2.10.4 The Company or the Customer shall advise the other party of any changes to the addresses designated for notices, other communications or billing, by following the procedures for giving notice set forth herein.

2.11 Taxes, Surcharges and Fees

- 2.11.1 E911 – Pursuant to applicable Pennsylvania rules and regulations, the Company shall mandate a monthly surcharge to be levied upon each business telephone line or trunk in the state including PBX trunks and Centrex equivalent trunks and each line or trunk serving and upon each user interface number or extension number or similarly identifiable line, trunk, or path to or from a digital network (such as, but not exclusive of, integrated services digital network (ISDN), Flexpath or comparable digital PBX, or connecting to or from a customer-based or dedicated telephone switch site (such as but not exclusive of, a PBX), or connecting to or from a Customer-based or dedicated central office.

Sales and Use Tax – All state and local taxes (i.e., sales tax) are listed as separate line items and are not included in the rates quoted in the Rate Schedules.

2.12 Disputed Bills

If any matter relating to a bill or deposit is disputed by a Customer, a thorough investigation shall be made by the Company. The results of the investigation shall be given to the Customer and every reasonable effort will be made to resolve the complaint. The normal method of constructing distribution facilities, i.e., aerial or underground, will be determined by the Company or its underlying carrier according to the conditions in each case, except as provided for under "Extensions to Serve New Customers" in 2.13.4(A) following.

The ownership of poles used in the provision of telephone service is vested either in the Company, its underlying carrier, or in some other company with which the Company or its underlying carrier has a joint use agreement.

Normally, no charges apply for extending telephone plant along public roads, highways, rights-of-way or easements, except for Conditions Involving Special Consideration.

2.14.3 Construction on Private Property

Charges based on cost may apply for the work to be done except in those cases where the reason for the change is beyond the control of the Customer and the service connection is re-established by the most practicable method. In this event, the service connection is normally re-established at no charge to the Customer.

c. Change from Aerial to Underground or Underground to Aerial Construction at the Customer's request.

B. Construction Required for Service to An Additional Termination Point (ATP)

1. General

- a. A Customer's main telephone billing number must terminate at the Customer's Rate Demarcation Point (RDP). A Customer's RDP and ATP must be located on the same property. Only supplemental services, billed to the main billing number or billed separately to the same Customer at the same address, may be terminated at an ATP.
- b. A Customer may request multiple ATPs on the same or different floors in a single or multi-tenant building, or in the same or different buildings on a single or multi-tenant campus.
- c. If a Customer desires to have services terminated at an ATP, it is the Customer's responsibility to inform the Company that the service is to be terminated at the ATP. If the Customer fails to fulfill this responsibility, the requested installations of the network services will be terminated at the Customer's RDP.
- d. Eighty-five (85) percent of the cable capacity used to establish an ATP will be available for assignment of network facilities.
- e. The minimum size cable installed to provide service to an ATP will have a capacity of 100 pairs.
- f. A subsequent Customer, other than the Customer charged for the construction of the ATP at a location where an ATP exists, and choosing to have network services assigned to the ATP, will be charged an ICB charge.

C. Maintenance and Repair

Circuits on private property, up to and including the RDP, are maintained and replaced at the expense of the Company except that:

1. Where repair or replacements are made necessary by damages caused by the Customer, his/her employees or representatives, or by water freezing in improperly drained conduit, or by any other circumstances over which the Customer has control, he/she will be required to bear the expense of the repairs or replacement, or if he/she desires, service will be established by means of the normal method of construction at the normal construction charge treatment. In the latter event, the charge applicable to a new service connection of the facilities also applies.
2. Where wire is buried in a trench provided by the Customer, and the Customer renders access to the circuits unusually expensive, e.g., lays a concrete walk or driveway over the circuits or places expensive shrubbery over them, he/she will be required to bear the unusual expense incurred in opening and closing the trench in connection with maintenance of the circuits, or if he/she desires, the Company will establish service by means of the normal method of construction at the normal method of construction at the normal construction charge treatment. In the latter event, the charge applicable to a new service connection of facilities also applies.
3. In connection with wire buried by the Company, where repairs or replacements are made necessary under circumstances similar to those in the preceding paragraph, such repairs or replacements will be made by the most practicable method, i.e., buried or aerial, as the case may be. If the most practicable method is aerial and the Customer desires underground, he/she must open and close the trench. Except where the customer opens and closes the trench, the charge applicable to a new service connection of the facilities also applies.

3.1 General

The Connection Charge is a nonrecurring charge which applies to:

- A. the installation of a new service;
 - B. the transfer of an existing service to a different location;
 - C. a change from one class of service to another at the same or a different location;
and
 - D. restoral of service after suspension or termination for nonpayment.
- Connection Charges are listed with each service to which they apply.

The Company alone may make changes in the location of its lines and equipment. When it is found that a move or change of such lines or equipment has been made by others, the Connection Charge for the underlying service will apply as if the work had been done by the Company. The Customer will be assessed a charge for any move, add, or change of a Company service.

Move, Add, and Change are defined as follows:

Add: The addition of a vertical service to existing equipment and/or service at one location.

Change: A change to any service, including rearrangement or reclassification, of existing service at the same location.

An optional per trunk Hunting feature is available for Customers which routes a call to the next idle trunk in a prearranged group.

3.13.1 General

The features in this section are made available on an individual basis. All features are provided subject to availability. Features may not be available with all classes of service. Transmission levels may not be sufficient in all cases.

3.13.2 Feature Descriptions

A. Three- Way Calling/ Call Hold

The Three-Way Calling feature allows a Customer to add a third party to an existing two-way call and form a three-way call. The call must have been originated from outside the station group and must terminate to a station within the station group. The Call Hold feature allows a Customer to put any in-progress call on hold by flashing the switchhook and dialing a code. This frees the line to allow the Customer to make an outgoing call to another number. Only one call per line can be on hold at a time. The third party cannot be added to the original call.

B. Call Forwarding

Call Forwarding, when activated, redirects attempted terminating calls to another Customer-specific line. The Customer may have to activate and deactivate the forwarding function and specify the desired terminating telephone number during each activation procedure. Call originating ability is not affected by Call Forwarding. The calling party is billed for the call to the called number. If the forwarded leg of the call is chargeable, the Customer with the Call Forwarding is billed for the forwarded leg of the call.

Call Forwarding – Busy automatically reroutes an incoming call to a Customer predesignated number when the called number is busy.

Call Forwarding – Don't Answer automatically reroutes an incoming call to a Customer-predesignated number when the called number does not answer within the number of rings programmed by the Company.

Call Forwarding – Variable allows the Customer to choose to reroute incoming calls to another specified telephone number. The Customer must activate and deactivate this feature.

C. Call Waiting/ Cancel Call Waiting

Call Waiting provides a tone signal to indicate to a Customer already engaged in a telephone call that a second caller is attempting to dial in. It also will permit the Customer to place the first call on hold, answer the second call, and then alternate between both callers.

Cancel Call Waiting (CCW) allows a Call Waiting (CW) Customer to disable CW for the duration of an outgoing telephone call. CCW is activated (i.e., CW is disabled) by dialing a special code prior to placing a call, and is automatically deactivated when the Customer disconnects from the call.

D. Distinctive Ringing

This feature enables a user to determine the destination telephone number of an incoming call from a distinctive ring. The user is provided with up to two additional telephone numbers.

E. Regular Multiline Hunting

This feature is a line hunting arrangement that provides sequential search of available numbers within a multiline group. This feature is not available everywhere.

F. Speed Calling

This feature allows a user to dial selected numbers using one or two digits. Up to eight numbers (single digit, or thirty numbers with two digits) can be selected.

The features in this section are made available on an individual basis. All features are provided subject to availability; features may not be available with all CLASS services. Transmission levels may not be sufficient in all cases.

3.14.2 Description of Feature

- A. Call Block: Allows the end-user to automatically block incoming calls from up to six end-user pre-selected telephone numbers programmed into the feature's screening list. Callers whose numbers have been blocked will hear a recorded message stating that their call has been blocked. The end-user controls when the feature is active, and can add or remove calling numbers from the feature's screening list.
- B. Repeat Dialing: allows a Customer to activate a code to automatically redial the last number dialed. The network periodically tests the busy/free status of the called line for up to thirty (30) minutes until both lines are found free and then redials the call for the Customer. The Repeat Dialing feature also allows Customers, having reached a busy number, to dial a code before hanging up. Repeat Dialing then continues to try the busy number for up to thirty (30) minutes until it becomes free. Once the busy line is free the call is automatically redialed and the Customer is notified of the connected call via a distinctive ring.

- C. Star Sixty- Nine (*69): function, dependent upon a Customer's serving Central Office, either automatically redials the telephone number of the most recent incoming call or delivers an audible announcement of the telephone number, date and time of the last incoming call and provides the Customer the option of automatically returning the call. If the telephone number is busy, the line of the most recent incoming call is monitored for a maximum of thirty (30) minutes. Once the busy line is free the call is automatically redialed and the Customer is notified of the connected call via a distinctive ring.

The following types of calls cannot be returned:

- Calls from PBX station lines

3.14.4 Caller ID Blocking

A. General

A calling party may block the passage of his/her telephone number, associated main listed name and voiceback of calling identification information to users or subscribers to Optional Central Office Services which utilize Signaling System 7 (SS7) technology. Blocking also will prevent call completion through the use of *69 Service. Customers have two blocking options as follows:

Per-Call Blocking – To activate per-call blocking, a Customer dials a special code prior to placing a call. Blocking will be activated for that outgoing call only. There is no charge for using per-call blocking, and it is provided on an unlimited basis. Per-call blocking is available to all Customers in the Company's serving territory.

Per-Line Blocking – Per-Line Blocking must be added to a Customer's line by contacting the Company's business office and having a service order issued. All calls are automatically blocked when a Customer subscribes to Per-Line Blocking unless the blocking feature is deactivated. If a Customer subscribes to Per-Line Blocking, they can deactivate blocking by dialing a special code prior to placing a call. Blocking will be deactivated for that outgoing call only. As facilities permit, a Per-Line Blocking Customer will be provided with a separate code to deactivate blocking, which is different from the per call blocking code. Where this separate code is not available, the code for per-call blocking and the code to deactivate Per-Line Blocking will be the same. Per-Line Blocking is available to all Customers in the Company's serving territory. Per-Line Blocking is provided without charge, except as discussed below.

Subsequent requests for Perline Blocking for the same Customer and telephone number at the same address may be charged the applicable non-recurring charge(s), which will be waived for Customers who are victims of domestic violence, the staffs of domestic violence programs and agencies, and emergency services personnel while performing their jobs.

Customers who use either per-call blocking or line blocking may be unable to complete calls to Caller ID subscribers who have activated the Anonymous Call Rejection feature (ACR) of Caller ID services. If a Customer using call blocking calls a Caller ID subscriber who has activated Anonymous Call Rejection, they will hear an announcement that the Caller ID subscriber is not accepting blocked calls. There are several ways to complete a call to a Caller ID subscriber who has activated ACR: (1) place the call through an operator; (2) place the call on the Company's network using a Company telephone calling card; or (3) place the call without blocking. Options (1) and (2) involve charges in addition to the cost of the call. However, the live operator surcharge will be waived for Customers who are victims of domestic violence, the staffs of domestic violence program and agencies, and emergency service personnel while performing their jobs. If the operator surcharge cannot be waived when the call is being placed, the Company will, upon notification, credit the live operator surcharge to the aforementioned party's telephone bill. Furthermore, should alternative methods become available in the future which permit the aforementioned to access the ACR party without revealing the caller's telephone number, the Company will waive any additional charges associated with such alternative methods. Blocked calls routed to the ACR announcement will not be rated as completed calls.

3.17 Integrated Services Digital Network (ISDN) Primary Rate Interface (PRI)

Integrated Services Digital Network (ISDN) is a set of transmission protocols that provides end-to-end digital connectivity and integration of voice, data and video, on a single Subscriber loop to support a wide variety of services via the public switched network. The Primary Rate Interface (PRI) consists of a 23B+D configuration with 23 64Kbps Bearer (B) digital channels and one 64 Kbps Data (D) digital channel. The B channels are designed for voice, data, image and sound transmissions. B channels can support synchronous, asynchronous or isochronous services at rates up to 64 Kbps. B channels can be aggregated for higher bandwidth applications. The D channel PRI provides the out of band signaling, call control and messaging.

PRI is provided through standard four wire DS-1 (1.544Mbps) point to point, private line facilities that enables Subscriber control of the 24 individual channels. PRI supports 1+, 0+, 7 digit and 10 digit IntraLATA and InterLATA services, as well as 01+ and 011+ international calling. PRI allows Subscribers to direct InterLATA voice, data and video over the Public Switched Telephone Network to the pre-subscribed IXC carrier of their choice, as well as 10XXX casual dialing. PRI also allows access to Public Switched Network services, such as Two-Way, Incoming Only, Outgoing Only and DID.

Multiple PRI interfaces can be combined to function as one group. Utilizing a Backup D Channel arrangement, Subscribers are able to link up 20 DS-1s together, providing a maximum of 479 64Kbps B Channels controlled by a single D (signaling) channel.

4.8 Toll Presubscription

4.8.1 Toll Presubscription is a procedure whereby a Customer designates to the Company the IntraLATA and InterLATA Toll Providers, i.e., Interexchange Carriers (IXCs) which the Customer wishes to be the carriers of choice for toll calls. Such calls are automatically directed to the designated carrier(s) without the need to use carrier access codes or additional dialing to direct the calls to the designated carrier. Toll presubscription does not prevent a Customer who has presubscribed to a toll carrier from using carrier access codes or additional dialing to direct calls to an alternative toll carrier on a per call basis.

Each carrier will have one or more access codes assigned to it for various types of service. When a Customer selects a carrier as its preferred IXC, only one access code of that carrier may be incorporated into the switching system of the Company permitting access to that carrier by the Customer without dialing an access code. Should the same end user wish to use other services of the same carrier, it will be necessary for the end user to dial the necessary access code(s) to reach that carrier's other service(s).

An IXC must use Feature Group D (FGD) Switched Access Service to qualify as a presubscription toll provider unless prior arrangements have been made with or by the telephone company. IXCs must submit an Access Service Request (ASR) to the telephone company.

Selection of toll presubscription provider by a Customer is subject to the terms and conditions following.

At the option of the IXCs, the nonrecurring charge for a change in toll presubscription, as provided herein, may be billed to the IXCs, instead of the Customer. This may involve charges resulting from end-user initial free choice Preferred Interexchange Carrier (PIC), as specified in Section 4.8.2 below.

4.8.3 Presubscription Charge Application

A. End user choices for toll presubscription:

Designating an intraLATA and interLATA IXC(s) as primary carrier(s) thereby requiring no access code to access those IXCs' service. End users are not required to choose the same IXC for intraLATA and interLATA toll presubscription. Other nonpresubscribed IXCs are accessed by dialing 10XXX, 101XXXX, or other required codes.

Choosing no carrier as a primary carrier thus requiring 10XXX or 101XXXX code dialing to access all IXCs.

B. If a new customer cannot decide upon presubscription IXCs, the Telephone Company may extend a 30-day period following completion of the initial service request to make a choice without charge. In the interim, the customer will be assigned as a 'No-PIC' and must dial an access code to make toll calls.

C. If an IXC elects to discontinue Feature Group, the IXC is obligated to contact, in writing, all end users who have selected the canceling IXC as their preferred toll provider. The IXC must inform the end users that it is canceling its Feature Group D Service, request that the end user select a new IXC, and state that the canceling IXC will pay the PIC change charge as provided herein. The IXC must provide written notification to the Telephone Company that this activity has taken place.

D. An unauthorized PIC change is a change in the presubscribed IXC that the end user denies authorizing. PIC disputes for end users are resolved through an investigative process.

If an unauthorized change in toll presubscription occurs, the IXC making the unauthorized change will be assessed a charge for unauthorized change in presubscription as provided at the end of this section. In addition, the IXC will be assessed the applicable charge for returning the end user to the preferred IXC.

4.8.4 End User Charge Discrepancy

- A. When a discrepancy is determined regarding an end user's designation of a presubscription IXC, the following applies depending upon the situation described:
- A signed letter of authorization takes precedence over any order other than subsequent, direct customer contact with the Telephone Company.
 - When two or more orders are received for an end user line generated by telemarketing, the date field on the mechanized record used to transmit PIC change information will be used as the PIC authorization date. The order with the latest application date/time determines customer choice.
 - If an end user denies requesting a change in toll presubscription as submitted by an IXC, and the IXC is unable to produce a letter of authorization, signed by the end user, the IXC will be assessed all applicable change charges. The nonrecurring change charges are provided herein. The IXC will also be assessed the presubscription change charge as specified herein, which was previously billed to the end user.
- B. Verification of Orders for Telemarketing

Neither the IXC or the Telephone Company shall submit a PIC change order generated by outbound telemarketing unless and until the order has first been confirmed in accordance with the F.C.C.'s current anti-slamming practices and procedures.

4.8.5 PIC Switchback Option-Business/Residence

PIC Switchback is an option under which no investigation activities are performed by the Telephone Company when an end user denies requesting a change in primary toll carrier submitted by the IXCs. The IXC participating in PIC Switchback will be billed the PIC Switchback Charge, and the presubscription change charge, as specified herein, to switch the end user to the end user's previous carrier.

When the Telephone Company is contacted by an end user who denies requesting a change in primary toll carrier, the end user will be credited the charge assessed for the disputed change in carrier, and will be switched back to the previous IXC at no charge. If this service is made available by the Telephone Company, IXCs may subscribe to or cancel PIC Switchback Service on 30 days notice to the Telephone Company by submitting a written request. A letter of authorization from the IXC will not be requested or accepted at a later date in the event of dispute of the charges assessed under the PIC Switchback option.

This option in no way relieves an IXC of the F.C.C. requirements for verifying all PIC orders obtained by outbound telemarketing prior to submitting those orders, or instituting steps to obtain verification of orders submitted to the Telephone Company.

In addition, the end user has the option of initiating a complaint to the F.C.C. or the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's Bureau of Consumer Services concerning unauthorized changes in toll presubscription.

5.3 Promotional Programs

5.3.1 General

The Company may establish temporary promotional programs wherein it may waive or reduce nonrecurring or recurring charges, to introduce a present or potential customer to a service not previously subscribed to by the Customer, and will file such programs with the Commission as a tariff supplement. Promotional service offerings will not have a duration period of longer than six (6) months in any rolling 12-month period which commences as of the effective date of the filed promotion.

5.3.2 Regulations

- A. Appropriate notification of a trial will be made to all eligible Customers and to the Commission. The Company will notify the Commission in writing at least ten (10) days before the start of any service or promotional trials. Appropriate notification may include direct mail, bill inserts, broadcast or print media, direct contact, or other comparable means of notification.
- B. During a Service Trial, the service(s) is provided automatically to all eligible customers, except those Customers who choose not to participate. Customers will be offered the opportunity to decline the trial service both in advance and during the trial. A Customer can request that the designated service be removed at any time during the trial and not be billed a recurring charge for the period that the feature was in place. At the end of the trial, Customers that do not contact the Company to indicate they wish to retain the service will be disconnected from the service at no charge.
- C. During a Promotional Trial, the service is provided to all eligible Customers who ask to participate. Customers will be notified in advance of the opportunity to receive the service in the trial for free. A Customer can request that the service be removed at any time during the trial and not be billed a recurring charge for the period that the service was in place. At the end of the trial, Customers that do not contact the Company will be disconnected from the service.

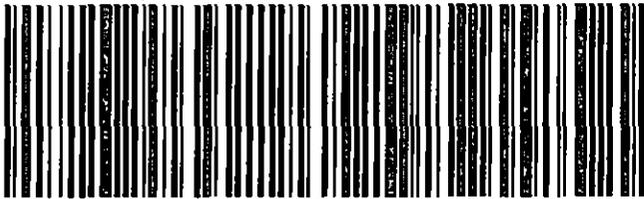
