NOTICE OF SECTION 529 PROCEEDING

To Deer Haven, LLC Water and/or Sewer Customers:

The Section 529 Proceeding

Deer Haven, LLC is your water and/or sewer service provider.

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“PUC”) initiated an investigation into Deer Haven, LLC (“Deer Haven”) under Section 529 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 529. The PUC initiated the Section 529 Investigation through its Ex Parte Emergency Orders for Deer Haven water on August 7, 2024 (as modified by the Commission’s Ratification Order on August 26, 2024) and for Deer Haven sewer on August 15, 2024 (and ratified by the Commission’s Ratification Order on August 22, 2024) (“Deer Haven 529 Proceeding”). Aqua Pennsylvania, Inc. and Aqua Pennsylvania Wastewater, Inc. (together “Aqua”) was named as Receiver for Deer Haven to provide water and wastewater service during the pendency of the Deer Haven 529 Proceeding. Through the Deer Haven 529 Proceeding the PUC will determine whether a capable public utility should acquire Deer Haven. The Docket Numbers for the Deer Haven 529 Proceeding are P-2024-3050545 and I-2024-3051540 for water, and P-2024-3050549 and I-2024-3051541 for sewer.

Notice of the Section 529 Proceeding and Opportunity to Participate

As a customer of Deer Haven, you are entitled to receive Notice of the Deer Haven 529 Proceeding and an opportunity to participate in them.

Actions You Can Take

You are not required to participate in the Deer Haven 529 Proceedings. Should you wish to participate, there are three ways to do so:

1. Sending a letter to the PUC. You can tell the PUC why you support or object to a capable public utility acquiring the subject system(s). This information can be helpful when the PUC investigates the issues. Send your letter, referencing the Docket Numbers P-2024-3050545 and I-2024-3051540 for water, and P-2024-3050549 and I-2024-3051541 for sewer, to the Secretary’s Bureau, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, Commonwealth Keystone Building, 400 North Street, 2nd Floor, Room-N201, Harrisburg, PA 17120. You can also contact the Pennsylvania Office of Consumer Advocate (“OCA”) with questions, concerns and comments. The OCA is an active party representing the interests of residential customers. The telephone number for the OCA is 717-783-5048 or toll-free 800-684-6560.

2. You can file a formal Petition to Intervene asking the PUC to allow you to be a party – the petition must state who you are, why you want to be a party, and what your specific concerns are. Petitions should include the Docket Numbers P-2024-3050545 and I-2024-3051540 for water, and P-2024-3050549 and I-2024-3051541 for sewer, and be sent to the Secretary’s Bureau, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, Commonwealth Keystone Building, 400 North Street, 2nd Floor, Room-N201, Harrisburg, PA 17120.

3. You can attend or be a witness at a public input hearing, if one is held, where you will have the opportunity to present your views to the Administrative Law Judge and the parties. All testimony given “under oath” becomes part of the official case record. If no public input hearings are held, you still have the right to attend any hearings that are held in the case but will not be permitted to testify unless you have requested and been granted permission to intervene or are called by a party as a witness.
