Application of Gettysburg & Northern Railroad for the alteration of the crossing where Herrs Ridge Road (DOT 593 418 P) crosses, at grade, the track of Gettysburg & Northern Railroad, located in Cumberland Township, Adams County.

To Whom It May Concern:

By Secretarial Letter dated November 16, 2023, the Commission approved the application of Gettysburg & Northern Railroad for the installation of upgraded signals and bell where Herrs Ridge Road (DOT 593 418 P) crosses, at grade, a single track of Gettysburg & Northern Railroad in Cumberland Township, Adams County. All work at the subject crossing was to be completed on or before December 31, 2024.

By letter-petition received on December 6, 2024, a representative of Gettysburg & Northern Railroad requested the Commission extend the completion date one (1) year to December 31, 2025, to complete the alterations due to unanticipated delays.

We have carefully reviewed the record in this proceeding and will grant Gettysburg & Northern Railroad's letter-petition for an extension of time to December 31, 2025.

THEREFORE:

The letter-petition received December 6, 2024, from Gettysburg & Northern Railroad be and is hereby granted to the extent herein directed:

1. Paragraph 9 of our Secretarial Letter dated November 16, 2023, which reads as follows, to wit:

“9. All work necessary to alter the subject crossing be completed in a manner satisfactory to this Commission on or before December 31, 2024, and that on or before said date, Gettysburg & Northern Railroad report in writing to this Commission the date of actual completion of the work.”

be and is hereby modified to read:

9. All work necessary to alter the subject crossing be completed in a manner satisfactory to this Commission on or before December 31, 2025, and that on or before said date, Gettysburg & Northern Railroad report in writing to this Commission the date of actual completion of the work.

2. In all respects not inconsistent herewith, our Secretarial Letter dated November 16, 2023, remain in full force and effect.

The Parties are reminded that failure to comply with this or any Order or Secretarial Letter in this proceeding may result in an enforcement action seeking civil penalties and/or other sanctions pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 3301.



If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to file by overnight delivery to ensure the timely filing of your submission. There are certain filings that cannot be eFiled, such as filings containing confidential or proprietary material. These must be submitted to the Secretary by overnight delivery, priority, or certified mail to allow tracking of your filing.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.31 and 5.44, file a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The Petition shall be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission or sent to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, and must be filed within twenty (20) days, or if no timely request is made, the action will be deemed to be a final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request; (2) the case docket number (it is provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter); (3) the party on whose behalf the petition is made; (4) a Certificate of Service on the other parties of record; and (5) a Verification with original signature in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36.
