Dear Attorney Brechlin:

By Order entered November 7, 2024, the Commission authorized Duquesne Light Company (the Company) to file a tariff supplement in the form set forth in Appendix A to the corrected Joint Petition for Approval of Settlement filed in the above docketed rate investigation. On December 9, 2024, the Company filed Supplement No. 85 to Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 25 to become effective December 20, 2024, designed to produce increased distribution operating revenues of \$85.1 million, inclusive of \$32.1 million of revenues currently recovered under surcharges, for a net increase in revenues of \$53.0 million, in compliance with the Order. On December 16, 2024, the Company filed revised tariff Pages No. 72, No. 73, and No. 74 to correct the page number on these pages.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, Supplement No. 85 to Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 25 is effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page of the supplement. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
