PHILADELPHIA GAS WORKS' MOTION TO CONTINUE

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §1.15, Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW”) hereby files this Motion to Continue the evidentiary hearing in this matter, which is scheduled for Tuesday, January 7, 2025. In support of this Motion, PGW states as follows:

1. By notice dated October 29, 2024, the Commission scheduled a telephonic hearing in this matter for Tuesday, January 7, 2025 at 10:00 a.m., before Deputy Chief Administrative Law Judge Christopher Pell.
2. Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.231(a) and the Prehearing Order issued in this matter, PGW has been working with the Complainant to reach a resolution in this case.
3. The parties are engaged in ongoing discussions regarding a suitable structure that will satisfy everyone’s needs; however, the parties have not yet reached an agreement.
4. PGW and the Complainant need additional time to attempt to resolve this matter.
5. PGW has spoken with Mr. Bell via telephone to discuss this request to continue the hearing.
6. Mr. Bell has stated that he has no objection to PGW’s Motion and that he agrees that additional time to discuss proposed designs would be beneficial.

WHEREFORE, PGW requests that the hearing scheduled for Tuesday, January 7, 2025, in the above captioned matter be continued.
