On behalf of Raiser-PA LLC ("Raiser"), enclosed is a firm check from Buchanan Ingersoll & Rooney for one hundred dollars (\$100.00), which is the fine amount requested by the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement to terminate further proceedings in connection with the above-captioned Complaint ("Complaint"). The Complaint alleges that Raiser is subject to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to a license issued to Raiser at Docket No. A-2016-2580821 on January 26, 2017, authorizing the transportation of persons for compensation in Transportation Network Company ("TNC") service. In addition, the Complaint alleges that Raiser is in violation of 66 Pa. C.S. §2606(a), governing that a vehicle cannot operate with passengers in greater numbers than the vehicle seat belt count.

Raiser does not contest payment of the requested fine and is forwarding this amount in order to resolve and close this Complaint.
