**CANCELLATION NOTICE**

Respondent:

On September 14, 2024, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement instituted a Complaint at Docket No. C-2024-3051152 against Good Cab LLC, Respondent, alleging that:

That PUC Enforcement Officer Matthew Ohlinger conducted a Driver/Vehicle Compliance report (DVCR) on that date on Monroe Street, Harrisburg, Dauphin County, PA. The vehicle was a 2011 Chevrolet Impala, registration number TX50064 the last 4 digits of the vehicle identification number being 7111, odometer reading 416,598, being driven by Jeffrey Stickle. Multiple violations were noted:

That following these inspections, Respondent was advised to submit criminal history and driver history reports. Officer Ohlinger did not receive those reports.

That Respondent allowed a vehicle to operate with a vehicle aged over 12 years and with mileage greater than 350,000 has violated 52 PA §29.314(c). The penalty for this violation is \$500.

That Respondent allowed a vehicle to operate with a vehicle that moves on a level surface when parking brake is fully applied, has violated 52 PA §29.402(1), 67 §175.64(c)(1). The penalty for this violation is \$50.

That Respondent allowed a vehicle to operate a vehicle with a dent greater than 4” inches, has violated 52 PA §29.403(6). The penalty for this violation is \$100.

That Respondent allowed a vehicle to operate with an exhaust leak which entered the passenger compartment, has violated 52 PA §29.402(1), 67 §175.75(b). The penalty for this violation is \$100.

That Respondent allowed a vehicle to operate without log sheets in the vehicle, has violated 52 PA §29.313(c). The penalty for this violation is \$50.

That Respondent allowed a vehicle to be operated by a person with a felony conviction, has violated 52 PA §505(b)(1)(i)(D). The penalty for this violation is \$1,000.

That Respondent failed to provide criminal history has violated 66 Pa.C.S 505. The penalty for this violation is \$100.

That Respondent failed to provide driver records has violated 66 Pa.C.S 505.. The penalty for this violation for a total of \$100.

In accordance with 52 Pa. Code §5.61, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement notified the Respondent that, an Answer to the Complaint must be filed within twenty (20) days of the date of service. The Notice further specified that, if Respondent failed to answer the Complaint within twenty (20) days, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement would request that the Commission cancel Respondent's Certificate of Public Convenience.

The Complaint was served on Respondent, Good Cab LLC by the U.S. Postal Service *via* Certified Mail on October 10, 2024, and was published in the PA Bulletin. To date, more than twenty days later, Respondent has failed to respond and a civil penalty of \$2,000 was not paid within twenty (20) days of the entry date of the Complaint.

Therefore, the allegations in the Complaint are deemed to be admitted. The Complaint is hereby sustained and the **Certificate of Public Convenience**, issued to Respondent, **Good Cab LLC, at A-632578 is hereby CANCELLED.**

Furthermore, this Commission will request the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to put an administrative hold on Respondent's vehicle registrations. Respondent will **NOT** be able to register any new vehicles or renew any existing vehicle registrations until a new application for authority is submitted. Additionally, all unpaid fines or assessments accrued while you had authority, are still due.

Respondent is hereby notified to cease and desist from further violations of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§1.1 *et seq.* and the regulations of the Commission, 52 Pa. Code §§1.1 *et seq.* In view of the **cancellation of Respondent's Certificates of Public Convenience**, it is specifically prohibited from rendering service as a common carrier by motor vehicle in intrastate commerce in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

## **APPEAL RIGHTS**

If you disagree with this determination, you may send a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. Such a Petition is a written statement asking the Commission to change its determination.

The Petition must be filed with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. If no timely request for reconsideration is made, this action will be deemed to be the final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request, (2) the case docket number(s) (they are provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter), (3) the name of the person on whose behalf the petition is made, (4) copies of relevant documentation, and (5) a verification with original signature. See 52 Pa. Code §§1.31 and 5.44. Below is a sample Verification:


