PHILADELPHIA GAS WORKS' MOTION TO CONTINUE

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §1.15, Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW”) hereby files this Motion to Continue the evidentiary hearing in this matter, which is scheduled for Wednesday, January 22, 2025. In support of this Motion, PGW states as follows:

1. By notice dated November 12, 2024, the Commission scheduled a telephonic hearing in this matter for Wednesday, January 22, 2025 at 10:00 a.m., before Administrative Law Judge F. Joseph Brady.
2. In the Complaint, Veronica Jackson (“Complainant”) indicated that she is disputing the accuracy of the bills for gas service due to a variety of issues with PGW’s facilities at the Service Address.
3. PGW is in the process of investigating the issues raised by the Complainant relating to accuracy of the bills and the condition of the fuel lines as well as other facilities at the Service Address.
4. PGW has been coordinating with the Complainant to schedule a field visit to the Service Address.
5. PGW will not be able to conclude its investigation prior to the scheduled hearing date.
6. PGW has spoken with the Complainant via telephone to discuss PGW’s request for a continuance in this matter; the Complainant has stated that she has no objection to PGW’s request and agrees that the matter should be continued so that PGW may conclude its investigation.

WHEREFORE, PGW requests that the hearing scheduled for Wednesday, January 22, 2025, in the above captioned matter be continued.
