Your Honor:

Pursuant to the instructions discussed in the hearing held on Friday, December 13, 2024, PPL Electric responds to the email sent by Gomattie Harilal (“Complainant”) via email on December 31, 2024 at 8:17 p.m. This untimely email raised a number of issues and allegations, including an objection to the “whole proceeding” and “this trial.” The Complainant also raised claims about the substance of their Complaint, made erroneous claims about the burden of proof in formal complaint proceedings, and claimed that PPL Electric has “rigged” the case, allegations that PPL Electric denies. While an evidentiary issue is raised, specifically an allegation and objection that “ppl puc and the judges are the only one to see the evidence,” these objections are without merit.

PPL Electric has taken several steps to serve hard copies of its exhibits on the Complainant. The original exhibits were sent to the Complainant prior to the hearing and were marked delivered by FedEx on Monday, December 9, 2024. The exhibits discussed in the hearing, which were redacted and unredacted versions of Exhibit 1, redacted and unredacted updated versions of Exhibit 1, and a confidential version of Exhibit 10, were sent to the Complainant on December 16, 2024, via both FedEx and through certified mail, to ensure both tracking and a signature. The tracking on the certified mail has not been updated since December 23, 2024, and notes that the mail is still en route to a transit facility. After making contact with USPS on January 14, 2025, we were informed that the piece of mail is missing. FedEx, however, sent a delivery notification on December 17, 2024, noting that the package was delivered to 106 Waterway Lane, Stroudsburg, PA 18360. This is the address the Complainant set forth in the Complaint, which was confirmed

by the Complainant during the hearing. Thus, the Company has served its exhibits on the Complainant.¹

PPL Electric respectfully requests that the objections be overruled and that the Company's exhibits as offered at the hearing be admitted into evidence.
