NOTICE THAT COMPLAINANT WILL APPEAL TO
THE COMMONWEALTH COURT OF PENNSYLVANIA

AND

AFFIRMATION THAT THE CURRENT ELECTRIC METER REMAINS IN PLACE DURING
ONGOING LEGAL PROCEEDINGS

1. This notice serves as our Affirmation That the Current Analog Electric Meter Remains in Place During our Ongoing Legal Proceedings.
2. Complainants intend to submit an Appeal to the Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania.
3. The current meter should remain in place until final disposition in this case is made at the appellate court level, whether that be the Commonwealth Court or the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania.
4. The following legal actions are in process whose outcomes may well affect the path forward for Complainants' case:
 - 4.1. Charles Hughes (CWC # 827C.D.2020)
 - 4.2. Judith Hendin (CWC # 766C.D.2024)

5. Complainants respectfully request that their current analog meter stays in place not only during their ongoing legal proceedings, but also until these other cases are completed in full as they may impact Complainants' instant case.
6. In leaving the current analog meter in place, West Penn Power/First Energy will not be harmed since Complainants pay their bill in full and on time each month.

Therefore, Complainants affirm that West Penn Power/First Energy will allow the current electric meter to remain in place during Complainant's ongoing case. The current electric meter will stay in place until:

1. A final disposition of the Complainant's case is made at a higher court; and
2. Final decisions are rendered in related cases, named *supra*, as these may impact the legal path forward for Complainant.
