

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The applicant is Commonwealth Transport LLC located at 554 W. King Street, Lancaster PA 17603. The witness preparing the statement is Nicholas J. Wachinski, Esquire, attorney for Commonwealth Transport LLC.

The equipment that will be used to complete the requested services subject to this Application are standard sedan model automobiles and wheelchair accessible vans, which have been properly outfitted for wheelchair bound, non-ambulatory service recipients. The sedan automobiles are not considered specialized equipment, the wheel chair accessible vans may be considered specialized equipment.

Applicant's facilities are located at 554 W. King Street, Lancaster PA, which is a commercial business space located in Lancaster, PA. Vehicles are stored in the publicly accessible lot. The personnel is comprised of both off duty law enforcement officers and other duly licensed and insured automobile drivers with operating privileges established by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation. All personnel have demonstrated proof of operating privileges and a safe driving record.

This request for emergency temporary relief does result from a warning issued by the Commission. However, the necessary process for authorization was already commenced and in place at the time of the warning. Counsel and Applicant, under the advice of Counsel, were also operating under the belief that exceptions to the authorization requirement through the Commission.




