Attention: You may lose the case if you do not come to this hearing and present facts on the issues raised.

You must serve the Presiding Officers with a copy of ANY document you file in this case.

CONTINUANCES. You may request a continuance of the hearing if you have a good reason. All continuances will be granted only for good cause. To request a continuance, you must submit a written request (a “motion”) at least five (5) days before the hearing. Your motion should include: 1) The case name, number, and hearing date; 2) The reason for the request; and 3) Whether each other party agrees.

REPRESENTATION. If you are an individual, you may represent yourself or you may have an attorney represent you. All others, including a partnership, corporation, trust, association, or governmental agency or subdivision, must be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in Pennsylvania, or admitted *pro hac vice*. Only an attorney may represent someone else. An attorney representing you should file a Notice of Appearance before the scheduled hearing date.

ACCOMMODATION. Any party who needs an accommodation for a disability in order to participate in this hearing process may request one. Please call the OALJ scheduling office at least five (5) business days prior to your hearing to submit your request.

If you require an interpreter to participate in the hearing, please call the scheduling office at least ten (10) business days prior to your hearing to submit your request.

PRESENTING EXHIBITS. If you intend to present any documents or exhibits at the Hearing, you must email a copy to the Presiding Officers at sthaas@pa.gov and egannon@pa.gov and to all parties of record. All copies must be received at least five (5) business days before the hearing, unless otherwise approved by the Presiding Officers. Do not re-send pre-served documents or exhibits. All documents or exhibits admitted into evidence must be submitted to the court reporter.

CONFIDENTIAL MATERIAL. If a filing contains confidential or proprietary material, the filing should be submitted by overnight delivery to ensure arrival. Large filings containing confidential or proprietary material may also be submitted through the Commission’s Share Point File system. These filings should be followed by a hard copy with a flash drive or CD for the Commission’s file. Filers should contact the Secretary’s Bureau in advance to set up a Share Point File before submitting the filing.

E-FILING. The PUC offers a free e-Filing Subscription Service. This service allows a user to file documents electronically and receive an automatic email notification whenever a document is added, removed, or changed on the PUC website in a specific case.
