ORDER
GRANTING RYAN FLYNN’S MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

On February 16, 2024, Ryan Flynn (“Mr. Flynn”) filed a Formal Complaint against the Pennsylvania American Water Company - Wastewater (“PAWC”) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”). In his Complaint, Mr. Flynn complained of incorrect billing in relation to a mobile home park that he owns. The Complaint was served on PAWC on March 12, 2024.

On April 1, 2024, PAWC filed an Answer to the Complaint, admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint.

On June 24, 2024, a Hearing Notice was issued scheduling this case for an evidentiary hearing on August 6, 2024.

On July 26, 2024, at the request of the parties, a Hearing Notice was issued cancelling the August 6, 2024, hearing and rescheduling it for October 8, 2024.

On October 2, 2024, at the request of the parties, a Hearing Notice was issued cancelling the October 8, 2024, hearing and rescheduling it for December 3, 2024.

On November 20, 2024, Lawrence Rosen entered his appearance on behalf of Mr. Flynn.

Also on November 20, 2024, Mr. Flynn filed a Petition for Issuance of Subpoenas.

On November 27, 2024, Mr. Flynn filed a Motion for Continuance, which was granted via Order issued December 2, 2024.

Also on November 27, 2024, a Hearing Cancellation Notice was issued cancelling the December 3, 2024, hearing.

On December 18, 2024, a Hearing Notice was issued scheduling the hearing for February 12, 2025.

On January 17, 2025, my Order Denying Petition for Issuance of Subpoenas was issued.

Also on January 17, 2025, Mr. Flynn filed an Amended Request for Issuance of Subpoenas.

On January 24, 2025, Paul J. Atencio entered his appearance on behalf of Mr. Flynn.

Also on January 24, 2025, Mr. Flynn filed a Withdrawal of the Amended Request for Issuance of Subpoenas.

On February 3, 2025, Mr. Flynn filed a Motion for Continuance (“Motion”). In its Motion, Mr. Flynn requests continuance of the February 12, 2025, hearing due to Attorney Atencio recently entering his appearance and needing to gather information concerning the case. Mr. Flynn further indicates that a continuance will allow the parties to further discuss settlement

of this case. Also, Mr. Flynn indicates in the Motion that PAWC did not object to the continuance.

The Commission's regulations provide that continuances will be considered only upon "good cause" shown. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b). As Attorney Atencio recently entered his appearance in this proceeding, I find that good cause exists to grant the Motion to allow Attorney Atencio time to gather information in this case so that he may be adequately prepared for any hearing held in this case. Further, granting the continuance will allow the parties to continue settlement discussions. The results that can be achieved as the result of a settlement can be more beneficial to the parties than the results of a fully litigated proceeding. Also, it has also been considered that PAWC did not object to the Motion.

For the above reasons, Mr. Flynn's Motion will be granted in the Ordering paragraphs below.

ORDER

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Motion for Continuance filed by Ryan Flynn on February 3, 2025, in the matter of Ryan Flynn o/b/o Liquid Management v. Pennsylvania American Water Company - Wastewater, Docket No. C-2024-3047272, is granted.
