On August 9, 2024, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) received Utiliz Services, LLC's Application for an Electric Generation Supplier (EGS) license. On September 19, 2024, the Commission served a Deficiency Secretarial Letter requesting missing or incomplete information. On October 9, 2024, Utiliz Services, LLC filed responses to the Deficiency Secretarial Letter. On October 25, 2024, and on November 25, 2024, respectively, the Commission served Data Requests for additional missing information. On November 25, 2024, and on January 8, 2025, respectively, the company replied to the Data Requests. In order for the Commission to complete a review of Utiliz Services, LLC's EGS Application, the Commission requires answers to the attached Data Request.


